The sun appears white from space and yellow from Earth.



How much time does it take for the sunlight to reach the earth?




Yes, when light leaves the surface of the sun, it takes 8 minutes to reach Earth - it's really fast!!!



The Sun gives us life because we are near as well as far, because we are exactly where we need to be, to have both cold and heat. We are at a good distance.




