A hundred years of the Open Air Museum

At the end of the 19th century, the Netherlands experienced a period of rapid change. The industrial revolution brought progress and prosperity, but crafts and traditions were faced with the threat of being lost forever. Established on 24th April, 1912 and open to the public since July, 1918, over the last century this museum has grown to become one of most visited in Nederlands.

This museum shows the history of ordinary people and tells a relevant story that is linked to the present, the past and the future.
