Project meeting held in Doetinchem 19-24. 9.2016

TASK: Creating a booklet for the visit to the museum



1. Websearch and presentation: in pairs/ groups search follow the instructions and prepare a short presentation about two art objects found in the Rijksmuseum

- Go to the Internet site www.rijksmuseum.nl
- Click on language and choose **English**
- Click on **Rijksstudio: dive into the collection**
- Click on **Search Rijksstudio**
- Search for **Adam van Vianen (example)**
- Choose **two art objects** that you find **interesting**
- Find information** about the two chosen art objects by clicking on the pictures . . .



- What's the title of the art object?
- What's the name of the maker?
 - When was it made?
- What can you see in terms of colours, lines, shapes, material, size, image, etc.. and how can you interpret these features?
 - Which details are important?
- What is the historical context? (think of events, maker, image, use)
 - Why did you choose this art object?
 - Where can you find it in the Rijksmuseum? which room?

h) **Download** a picture of the chosen art object and write down the information found (maximum one A4 piece of paper per object). Then print the two reports (one per object) and also email them to the teacher. Don't forget to put your names on it!

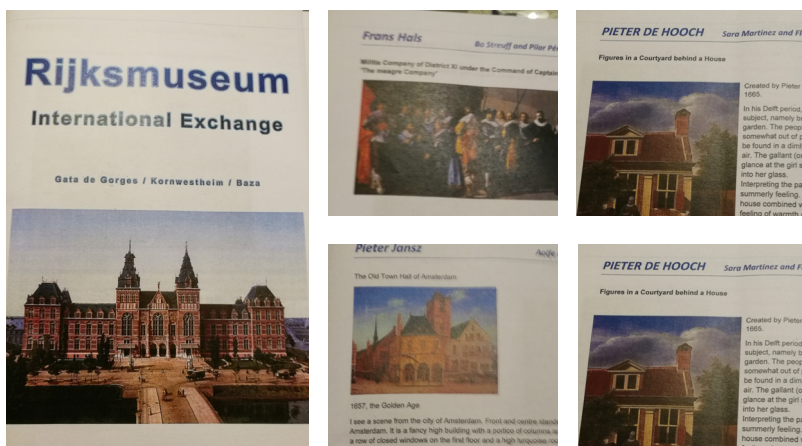
i) **Prepare a short presentation** about the two art objects chosen - max. 7 minutes

- Ask the members of the group if they like the objects you have chosen
