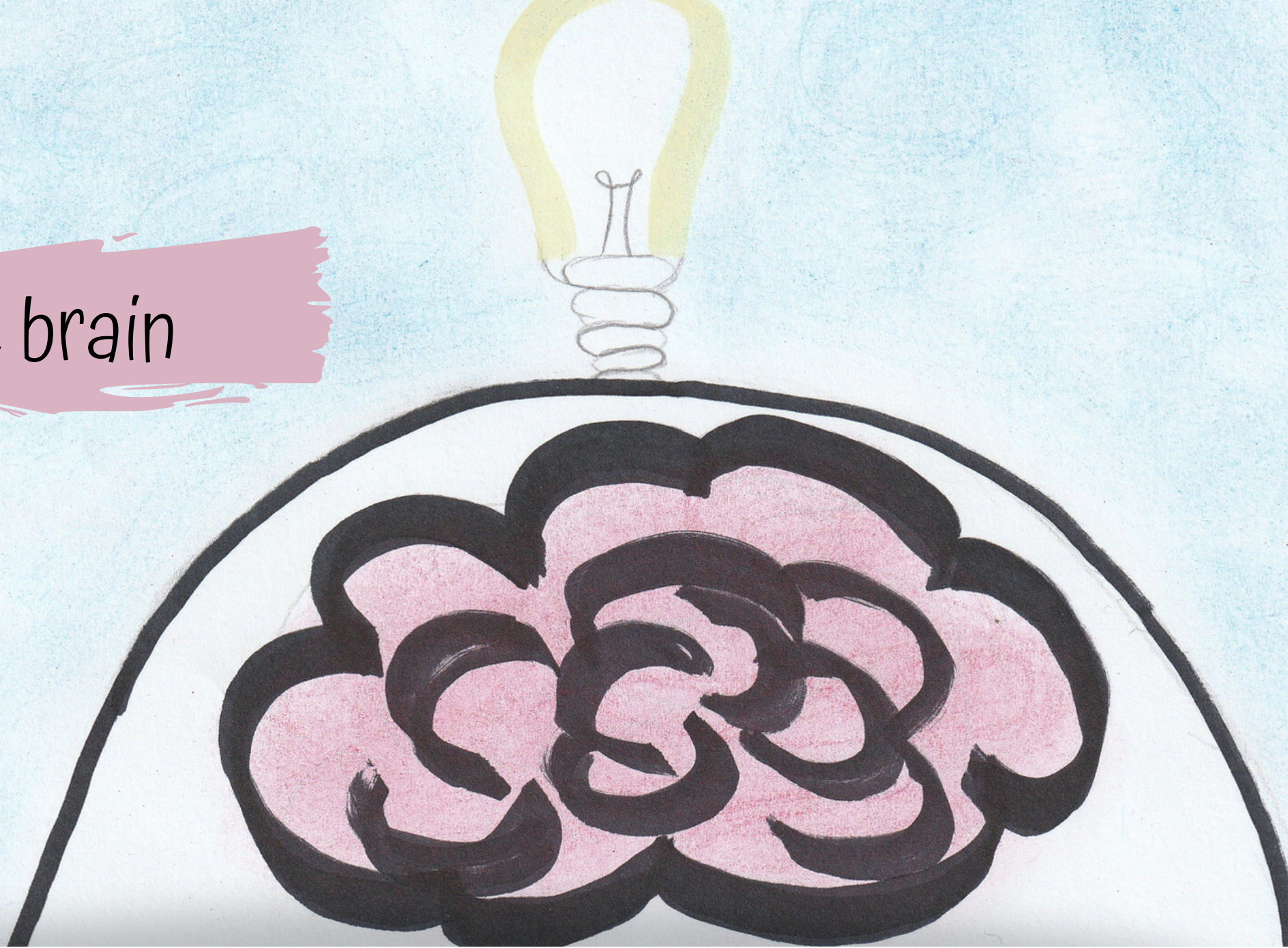
# the rooster



I'm not a king, I wear a crown. I'm not a clock, I tell the time. What am I?



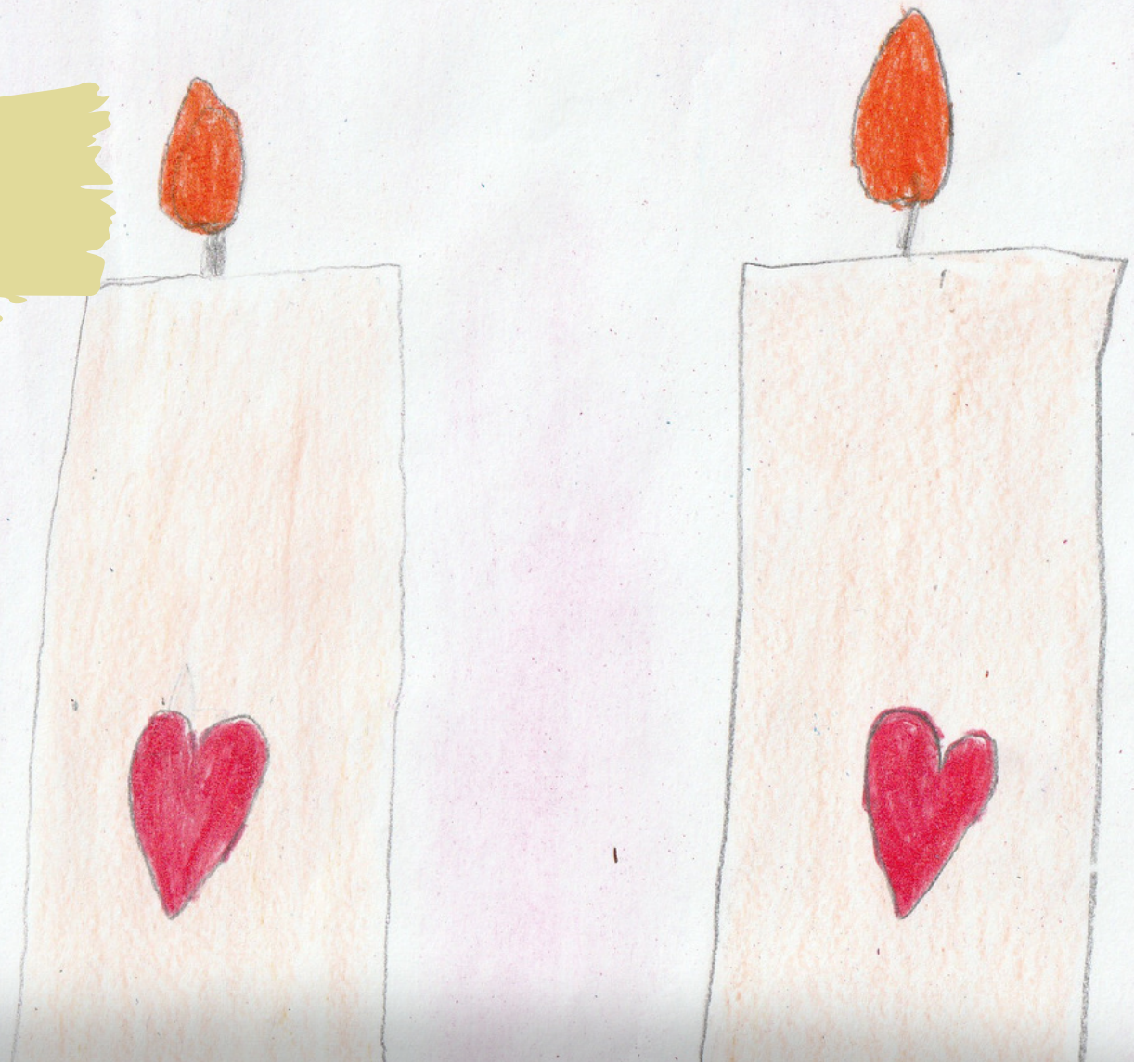
the brain

It is a whole word, but it has only one letter. What is it?

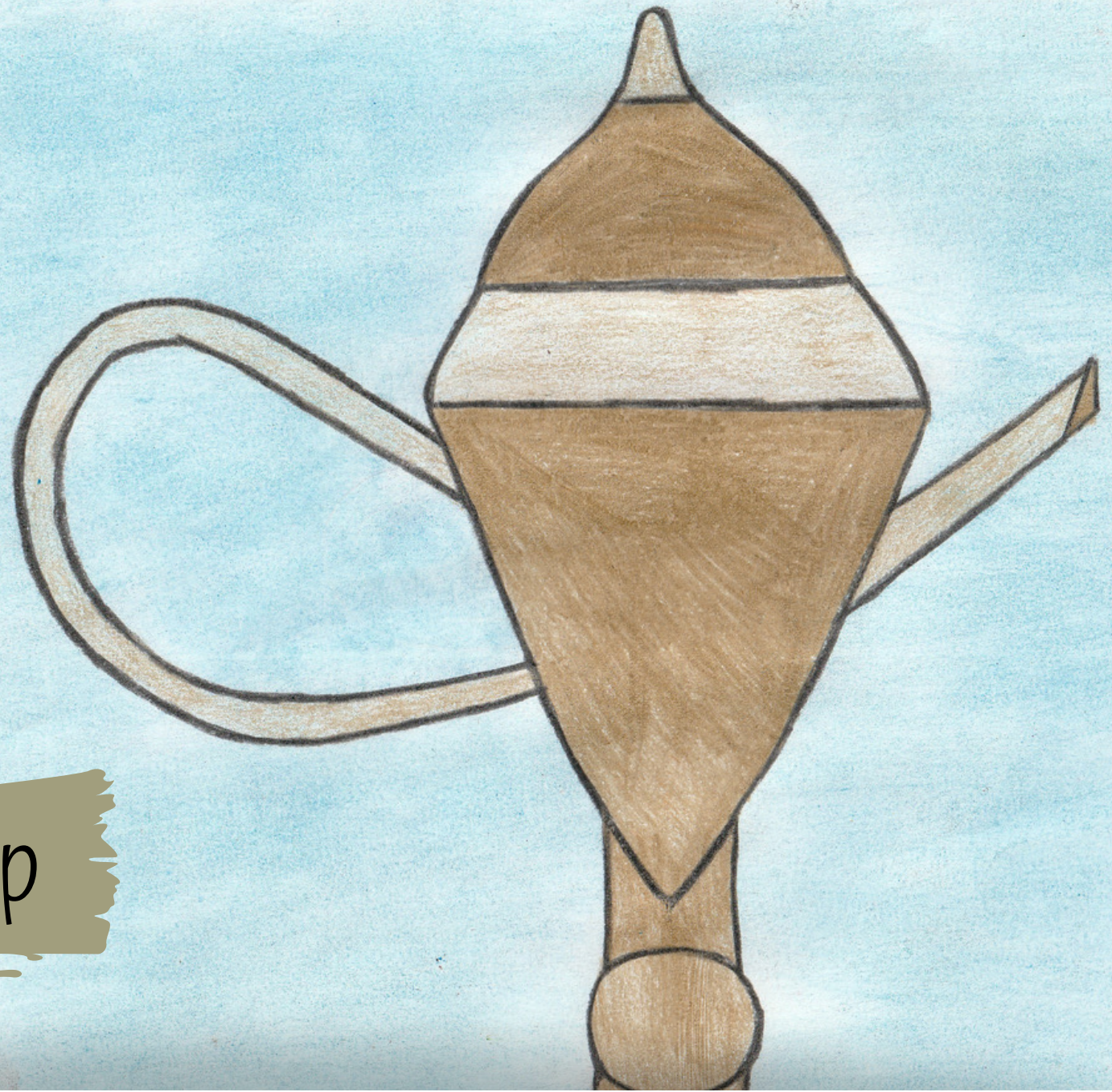




the tongue

I asked how much a kilo would cost. It looks me brightly in the face.



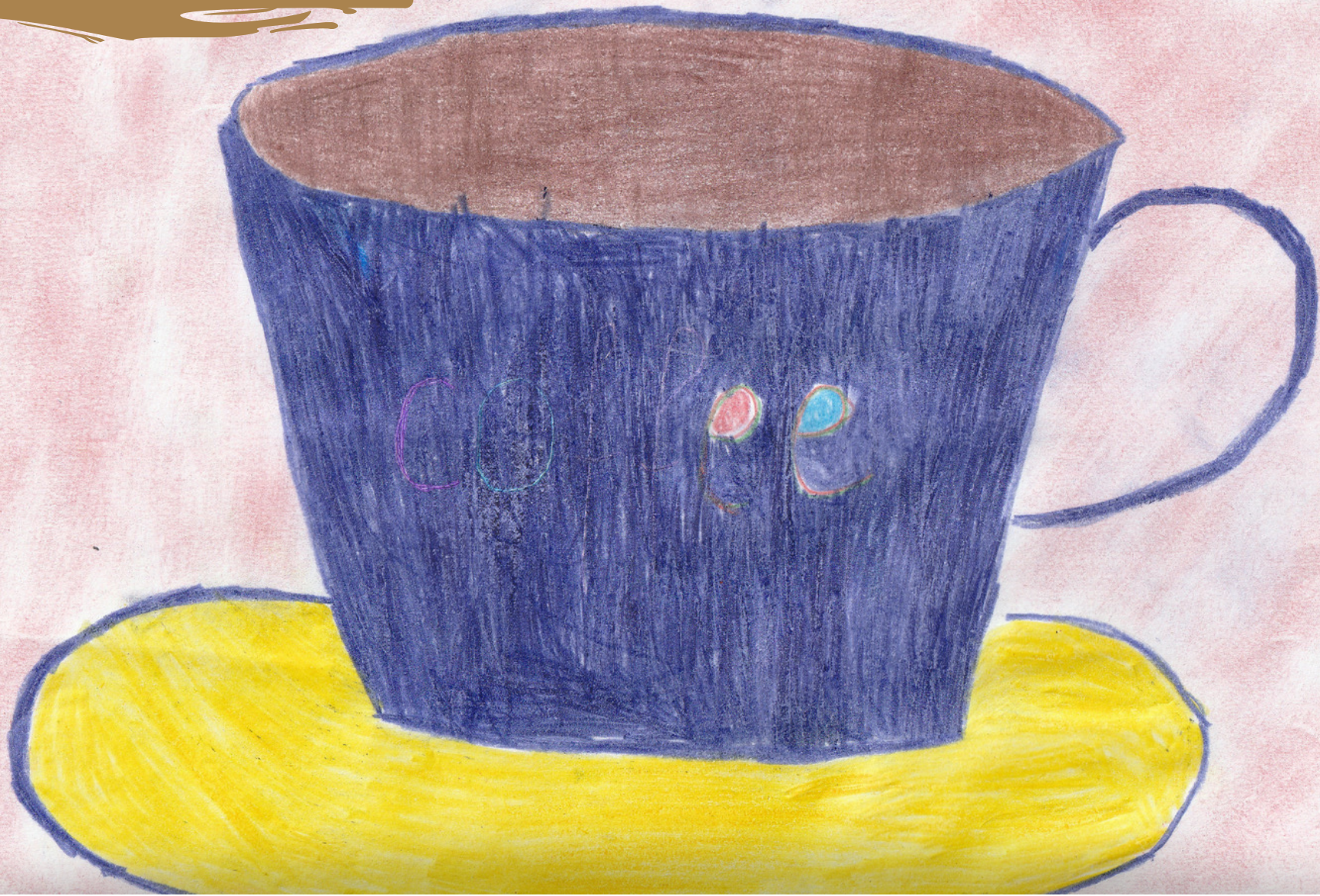


a star
