
Greece Riddles

I asked how much a kilo would cost. It looks me brightly in the face.




I have a bagful of walnuts I can never finish counting.




Two brothers grew up together. Their tops burned, their heads burned. They are the ones who were beaten.

With two columns and a thousand tiles.




It was us, us, us. Thirty-two maidens.
The breakers came and broke us up. Now we are back in order again...






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It has ocean but no water. Who am I?
