## 1. Gender of respondents



## Conclusions to the question 1 :

- Women accounted for $52 \%$ of respondents.

Men accounted for $48 \%$ of respondents.

Therefore, slightly more of the respondents were women.

## 2. Age of respondents



## Conclusions to the question 2 :

The largest group of respondents were people under the age of 18 , as much as $58 \%$.

- The respondents aged 18 to 40 constituted 26\%.
- People over 40 years old are only 16\%.


## 3. Education of respondents

## Conclusions to the question 3:

- The largest group were respondents with primary education, as much as $59 \%$.

The least numerous group were people with secondary education, as only $8 \%$.

## 4. Place of residence



## Conclusions to the question 4:

- The vast majority of respondents live in the village - 83\%.

The respondents living in the city are only $17 \%$ of those questioned.

## 5. Do you know any foreign languages?

## Conclusions to the question 5 :

- $92 \%$ of respondents said they know a foreign language.
- Less than $8 \%$ of people say they do not know any foreign language.


# 6. If you know foreign languages, what are they? 



## Conclusions to the question 6:

The respondents most often indicated the knowledge of English - 53\% and German 39\%.

- It should also be noted that 3\% of the school community knows different languages than English, German or Russian.


## 7. Are you planning to go abroad permanently?

## Conclusions to the question 7 :

- Most of the respondents, as many as $72 \%$ say that they do not want to go abroad permanently.
- People who want to leave Poland permanently account for $28 \%$ of respondents.

## Conclusions to the question 8:

- When it comes to going abroad permanently, the respondents most often mention such countries as:
* England - 29\%
*Germany- 25\%
* Other countries than those included in the survey - $21 \%$.


# 9. Do you use foreign phrases in speech? 



## Conclusions to the question 9:

- As many as $74 \%$ of respondents claim that they use foreign phrases in speech.
- However, people who do not use foreign phrases in speech constitute $26 \%$ of respondents.


## 10. Do you use foreign phrases in writing?



## Conclusions to the question 10 :

- Slightly more than half of the respondents $55 \%$ declare that they use foreign phrases in a letter.
- Slightly less than half - $45 \%$ are people who do not use foreign phrases in writing.


## 11. Do you eat in a restaurant with a focus on cuisine from another country?



## Conclusions to the question 11:

- 64\% of the people interviewed eat in the restaurants with a focus on the cuisine of other countries.
- $24 \%$ of our respondents do not eat in such restaurants.

There were $12 \%$ of the people questioned without a sentence.

# 12. What kind of entertainment do you prefer the so-called cinema or book?

## Conclusions to the question 12 :

The respondents chose mainly Polish entertainment - 47\% and foreign - 30\%.

- There were $23 \%$ of respondents without the opinion.


## 13. Are you in favor of introducing one common currency for many countries? (e.g., euro)

## Conclusions to the question 13 :

- Against the introduction of one single currency for many countries, $47 \%$ of the respondents were in favor.
- The introduction of one common currency was $36 \%$ of the respondents.
- Only $17 \%$ of the questioned community have no opinion on this topic.


## 14. When you buy a product, do you pay attention to the country it comes from?



## Conclusions to the question 14 :

- More than a half $-57 \%$ of those questioned while shopping, are not suggested by the countries from which the product comes.
- The respondents who are governed by these premises constitute $27 \%$.
- $16 \%$ of the respondents have no opinion on this topic.


## 15. How do you get in touch with an alien culture?

## Conclusions to the question 15:

The respondents said they had mainly contact with foreign culture through the media - 79\% and foreign trips - 10\%.

There are also people who believe that they have no contact with foreign culture - 10\%.

## 16. What is your attitude to foreign cultures?

## Conclusions to the question 16 :

- More than half of the respondents - $68 \%$ said they are interested in foreign cultures.
- People who are not interested in foreign cultures accounted for $32 \%$ of the respondents.


## 17. Do you think it is good that we have so easy access to foreign cultures today?



## Conclusions to the question 17 :

The majority of respondents - 73\% say that it is good that we have so easy access to foreign cultures today.

There were $16 \%$ of the people questioned.

- $11 \%$ of respondents were without an opinion.


# 18. Do you think that the Polish tradition is threatened by the inflow of immigrants and mixing our culture with their culture?

## Conclusions to the question 18 :

- Here, the responses of the respondents were divided almost equally.
- 33\% of respondents replied positively, negatively - 35\%, and 32\% of respondents did not have an opinion.


## 19. Will the numerous arrivals of

 foreigners to European countries contribute to the increase in unemployment?

## Conclusions to the question 19:

- As many as 46\% of respondents claim that arrivals of foreigners to European countries contribute to the increase in unemployment.

The percentage points were almost equally distributed in terms of people who responded negatively - $25 \%$, or those who had no opinion on this topic - 29\%.

## 20. Would you take a foreigner to your home?



## Conclusions to the question 20:

Only 26\% of respondents would take a stranger to their home.

As many as 53\% of the respondents did not express such a willingness.

There were also people who had no opinion on this topic - 21\%.

## 21. Are you a patriot?



## Conclusions to the question 21 :

The vast majority of people participating in the survey $-89 \%$, claims to be a patriot.

- People who believe that they are not patriots account for $11 \%$ of the respondents.


## SUMMARY

The vast majority of respondents learn willingly foreign languages.

- The local society is interested in learning about the customs of other countries.
- Getting to know foreign culture is mainly due to the media.


## SUMMARY

- Most of the respondents oppose the implementation of one single currency for many countries.
- Society undergoes stereotypes, created mainly by the media.
