1. Learning/Training activity in Denmark February 5th-11th

The covid19 situation still effects many countries and schools. Finland and England are not able to send anyone for the LA/TT in Denmark. Malta will send 3 teachers, Turkey 2 teachers + 4 students and Iceland 2 teachers + 4 students.

Denmark has sent everyone the latest versions of programs for pupil + teacher activities. The programs have also been uploaded to Twinspace.

Program on Saturday and Sunday:

Due to different arrival times and long journeys, we decided to drop a joint dinner. Elisa will come and meet the Turkish and Icelandic group at the station with the families on Saturday.

On Sunday morning Brita will walk you to school. She will start at Palads hotel (Malta) at 9.30. Then at Oasen 9.35 (Iceland - Elisa will pick up Elisabeth's luggage to take along to her host family) and at Peak 12 (Turkey) at 9.40.

Lunch: Denmark will buy the missing ingredients to Turkish Tarhana soup, ingredients to bake bread and something for dessert.

Dinner: We will decide together on Sunday, whether we want to meet for a joint dinner in the evening, or have some time to adjust in the evening.

Program on Wednesday and Thursday:
