## 4.1 Information regarding travel to Denmark

Nordre Skole is happy to welcome both pupils and staff to take part in the Learning/Training Activity in Denmark but unfortunately, we will not be able to offer host families for the pupils. We will try to find host families where the visiting pupils can spend some time in the afternoon/evening, possibly have the meal together in the evening.





You are required to wear a mouthpiece in shops, public transport, taxis and public buildings like train stations, airports, bus stations etc. You will also need to follow social distancing and keep up good hand hygiene. If required, be prepared to show a corona passport to proof that you are vaccinated if you are over 15 years old (in restaurants and public transport, also at schools).

Schools are considered as public buildings for visitors, eg. parents are asked to wear a mouthpiece if entering the building. The teachers and pupils don't wear a mouthpiece inside and I think it's up to you whether you want to do it or not.

# Monday Feb 7th

#### **Preparation at home:**

- **2.** The visiting pupils are asked to make a short introduction pp/film/speech about their lives. These can be used in classes.
- **3. The visiting teachers**: Be prepared to make a workshop of approximately 70-90 minutes. It could be something about your country/culture/language combined with some creative activities typical for your country. It could also be an ACTIVE activity where you go outside and train eg. team work/friendship/getting to know one another etc.

## Wednesday 9th and Thursday 10th

There has been invited 4 guest teachers: Sia and Martin from Animation School and Lommefilm in Viborg/Aarhus and Magdi and Amanda from Piximakey in Copenhagen to teach us about animation and film. This program is both for the students in grades 5-8 and all visiting pupils and teachers.





Piximakey will use these days as a showcase for their Piximakey Education (an animation toolbox) and will provide us with materials and knowledge about animation/21<sup>st</sup> century skills, both in Danish and in English. Sia and Martin will invite 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders to work with Imovie and their dreams for the future. These films will also be a part of both their and our project.

All participants will get to sign an agreement of the use of film/photos as documentation for these days (GDPR).

# To prepare at home for the evening:

Prepare a dance/song from home to share during our joint farewell dinner on Thursday evening.

## 4.3. The Expenses in Denmark

The cost of the guest teachers is approximately 2700 euros. We will try to cover that from our budget. I might need to ask some money from each school to cover the expenses for food. It will be **maximum 50 euros/person. This will be paid to our school's secretary.** 

Besides travel and accommodation, you would have to calculate 50 euro/person for food at school per person. Then you have to calculate lunch/dinner marked with a PLUS (+).

Breakfast at a hotel might be self-catered, included in the price of the room or to be paid. Lunch we will provide to you at school in all days. Dinner costs approximately 20-30 euros/person in a restaurant. You can get a pizza for approx. 10 euros, kebab for the same. The drinks are expensive at a restaurant (even non-alcoholic) fx. you might order a pizza for 12 euros and a coca cola for 7 euros.
