1. Update of the travel situation

The Finns have finally got a permission to take part in the LA/TT in England with 4 adults - headmaster and 3 teachers.

The Danish head teacher has unfortunately cancelled his participation due to work reasons.

The Turkish are still struggling with the visa. If they get the visas on Friday, they will be able to join the whole program. The office is closed during weekends, so the second scenario is to get the visas on Monday and then travel to England. That would mean that the group could take part in the last three days of the program. We agreed, that the most important thing is that they come to England, nevertheless of the length of their stay. We cross fingers for early visas!
