Turkey is a gateway between Europe and Asia continents, The European and Asian sides are divided by the Istanbul Boğazı, the country is encircled by seas on three sides: the Aegean Sea to the west, the Black Sea to the north and the Mediterranean Sea to the south. Turkey is bordered by eight countries: Bulgaria to the northwest; Greece to the west; Georgia to the northeast; Armenia, Azerbaijan and Iran to the east; and Iraq and Syria to the southeast. The population of the country is about 79 million people and the capital city of Turkey is Ankara.




ABOUT TURKISH EDUCATION SYSTEM

- Official Language: Turkish
- Academic Year : From September through June
- Duration of Schooling : 4+4+4
- Compulsory Schooling: 12 years (ages 6 to18)



Turkish National educational system has two main parts:



Non-formal Education



FORMAL EDUCATION

Formal education includes

- Pre-primary education
- Primary school education
- Secondary school education
- High school education
- Higher education institutions (Universities)



PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

- Pre-primary school education is optional.
- It is not compulsory.
- But most parents send their children to preprimary school.
- Pre-primary school education involves the education of children ages between 3 and 6.
- Their objective is to ensure that children develop physically, mentally and emotionally and ready for Primary Education





PRIMARY EDUCATION

- Primary school age is between 6 and 10 years old.
- Primary education is compulsory for all the citizens
- It is given free of charge in public schools.
- Foreign language lessons start at the 2nd grade



SECONDARY EDUCATION

- Secondary school education age is between10 and 14 (from the 5th to the 8th grades)
- Secondary education is compulsory
- It is also given as free of charge in public schools.



HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION

- High school education age is between 14 and 18 (from the 9th to the 12th grades)
- High school education is compulsory
- When they finish high school ,the students get their high school diplomas.



Higher education institutions (Universities)

- There are different departments lasting for 2 years or lasting for 4 years.
- There is an exception. Only the Faculty of medicine lasts for 6 years
- The students are adopted the universities through two examinations called YGS and LYS in short
- Students have to take two general exams in order to enrol a university.
- There are 193 universities in Turkey

Our school has been established in 1956. There are 60 teachers and 1000 students aged between 10 to 14. The school has a kindergarten with 4 to 6 years old. Our school has got Special Education Needs **Classes with 10 students with learning difficulties and mental** disabilities. The school has got 15 classrooms with smart board in every class, one IT labs with non-stop network system. Math, Turkish, English, Science and Technology, Social Studies, physical Education, Visual Art, Music, Informative Technology, Religion and Morals, Technology and Design are main subject in our school.


