One in five children in developing countries live in poverty and their probability to die before the 5th birthday is 3 times more frequent

Poverty takes away from children the things they need most: food, education, health services, water and hygiene

Children with disabilities in the poorest countries die more frequently because of no medical equipment or assistance

The 80% of disabled people live in developing countries, only 28% of persons with disabilities have access to disability benefits in the world but they are only 1% in the poorest countries
