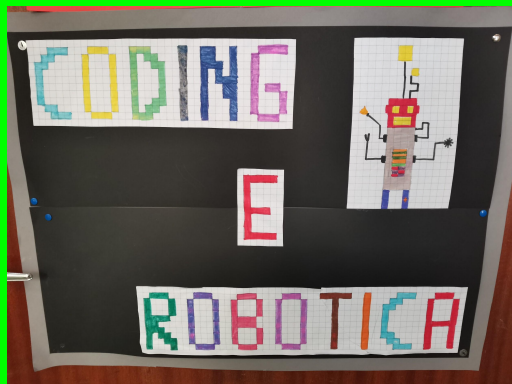

...that we also conduct in our big garden and in all the green areas in the surroundings. Take a look!

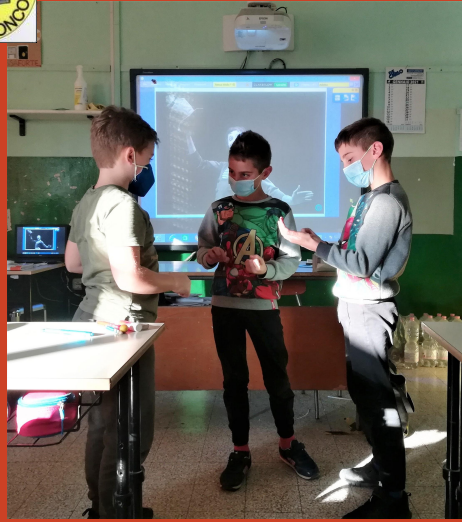

In our school children of all ages have always been working together. This year we are trying to do the same but always outside, carefully keeping our distance and wearing masks.



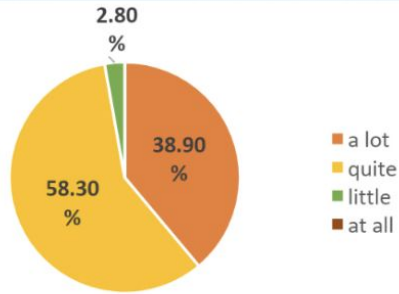

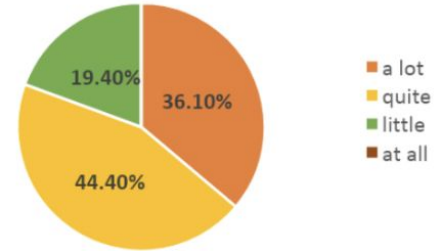

1. At the end of this 3-year school course, how much has your school helped you find out and develop your skills and attitudes?



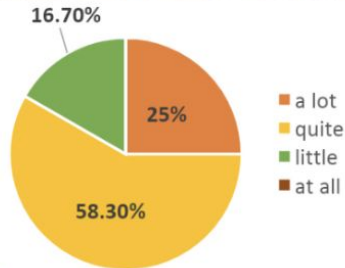
2. How much has your school, also through its educational projects, affected the improvement of your well-being (healthy diet, physical activity, respect for the environment, responsible use of the web...)?



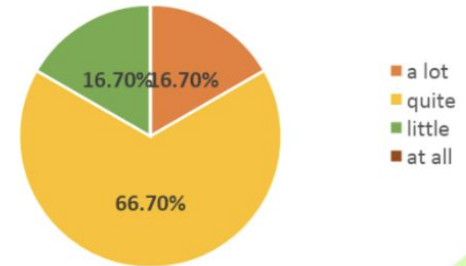
COSSATO SCHOOL WELL-BEING REPORT
