Fernado Pimenta

Fernando Pimenta is a very medaled Portuguese canoeist that make history for Portugal national team.

He won the silver medal at the K-2 1000 m event at the London 2012 Olympics along with Emanuel Silva.

On May 27, 2015, he was made Grand Officer of the Order of Infante D. Henrique. On July 10, 2016, he was made Commander of the Order of Merit.



On 27 August 2017, he became world champion at K1 5000 in the Czech Republic by finishing the race at 20: 46.907 (the day before, he had already won the silver medal at K1 1000 meters). Consequently, on the same day, he was elevated to Grand Officer of the Order of Merit, a distinction given to him at a ceremony held on March 6, 2018.
