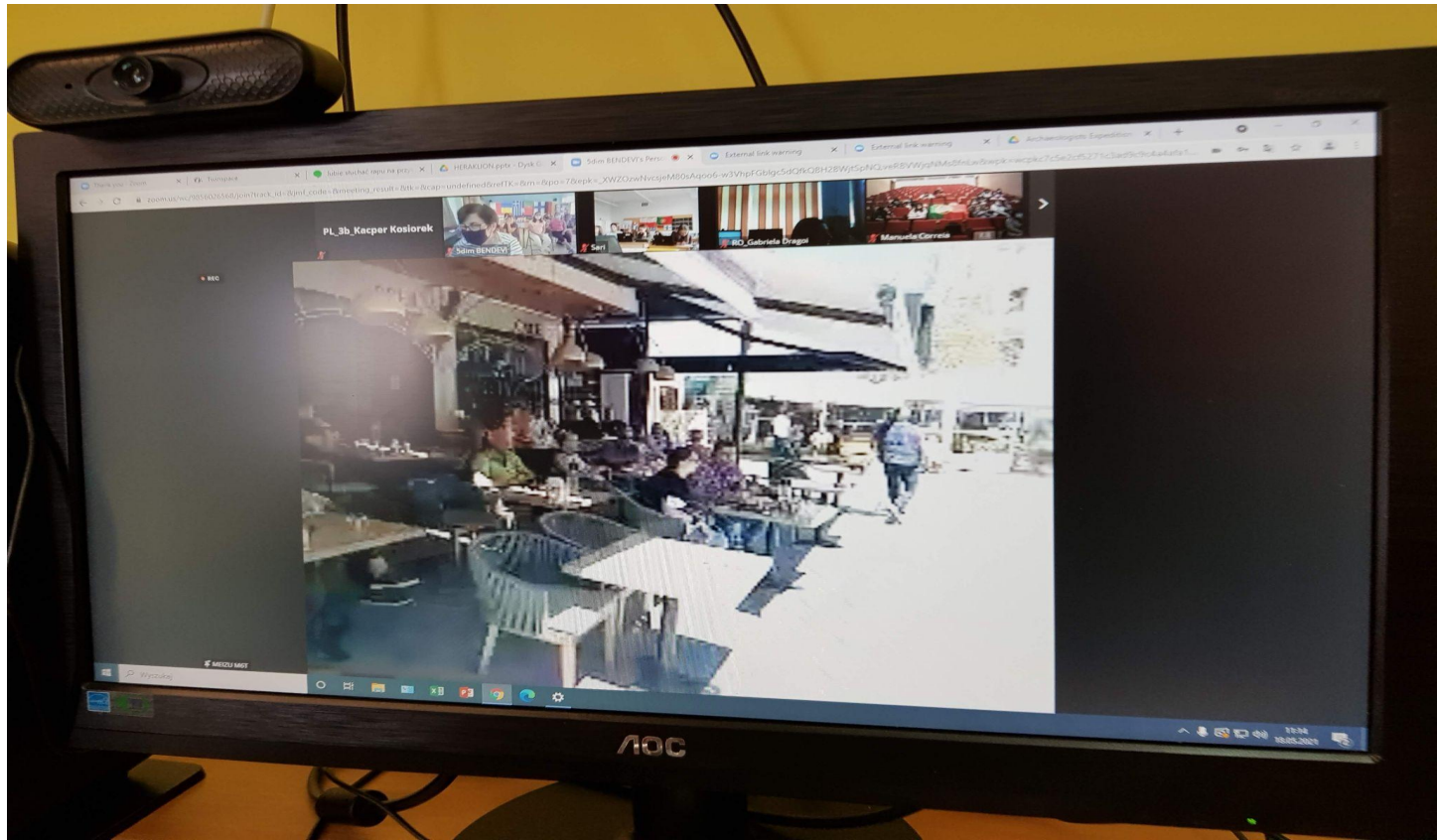
TUESDAY

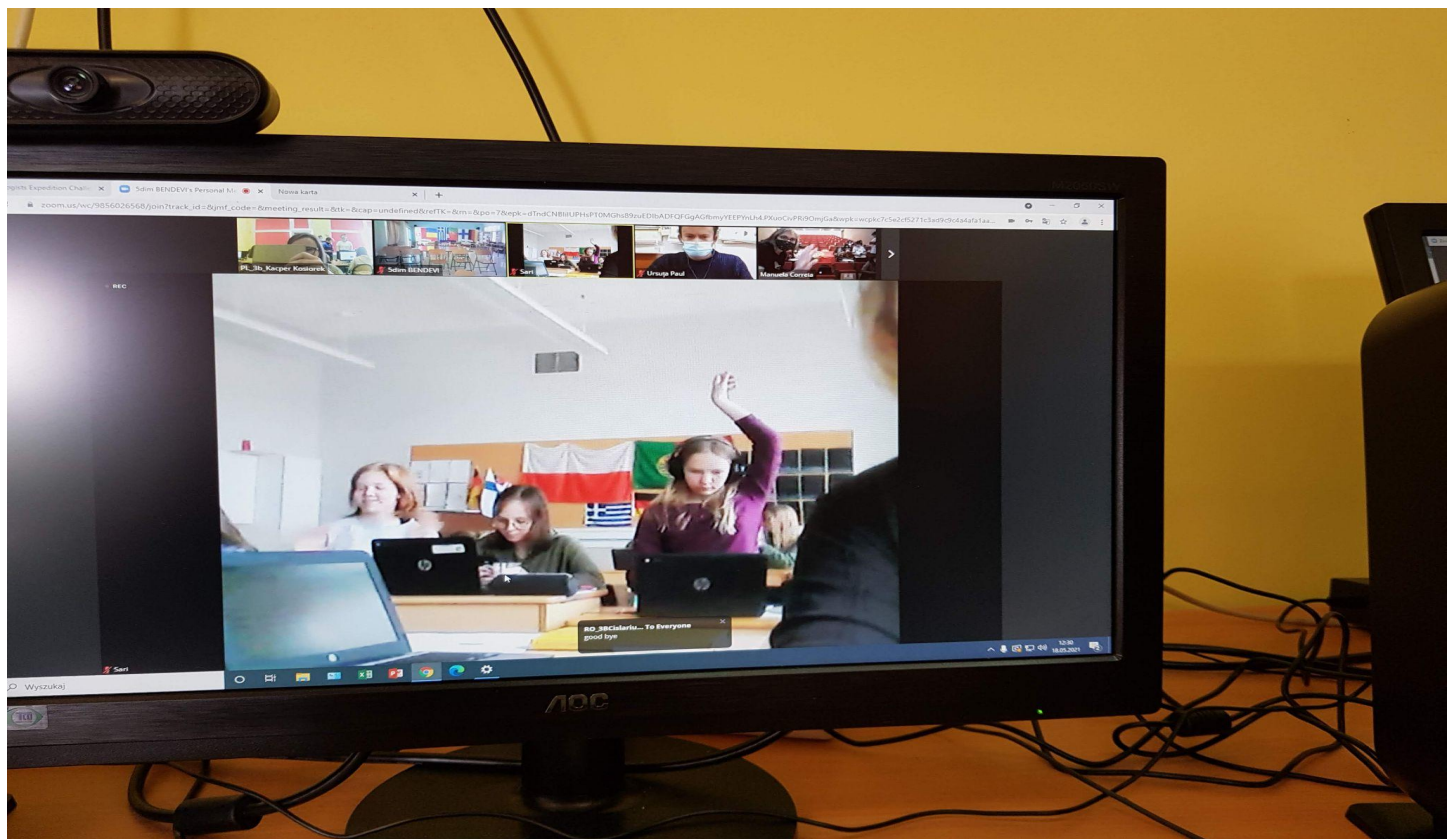

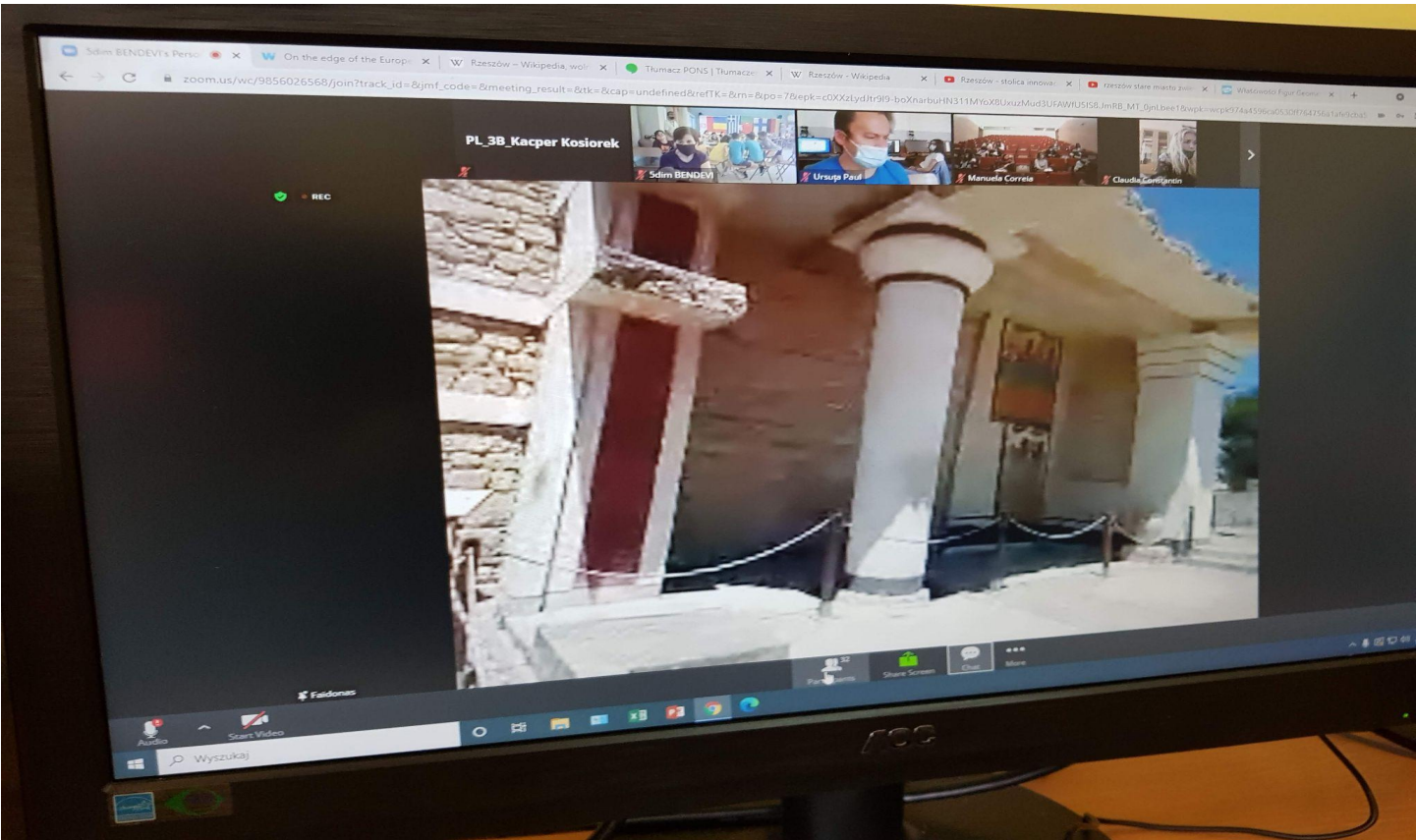
WEDNESDAY

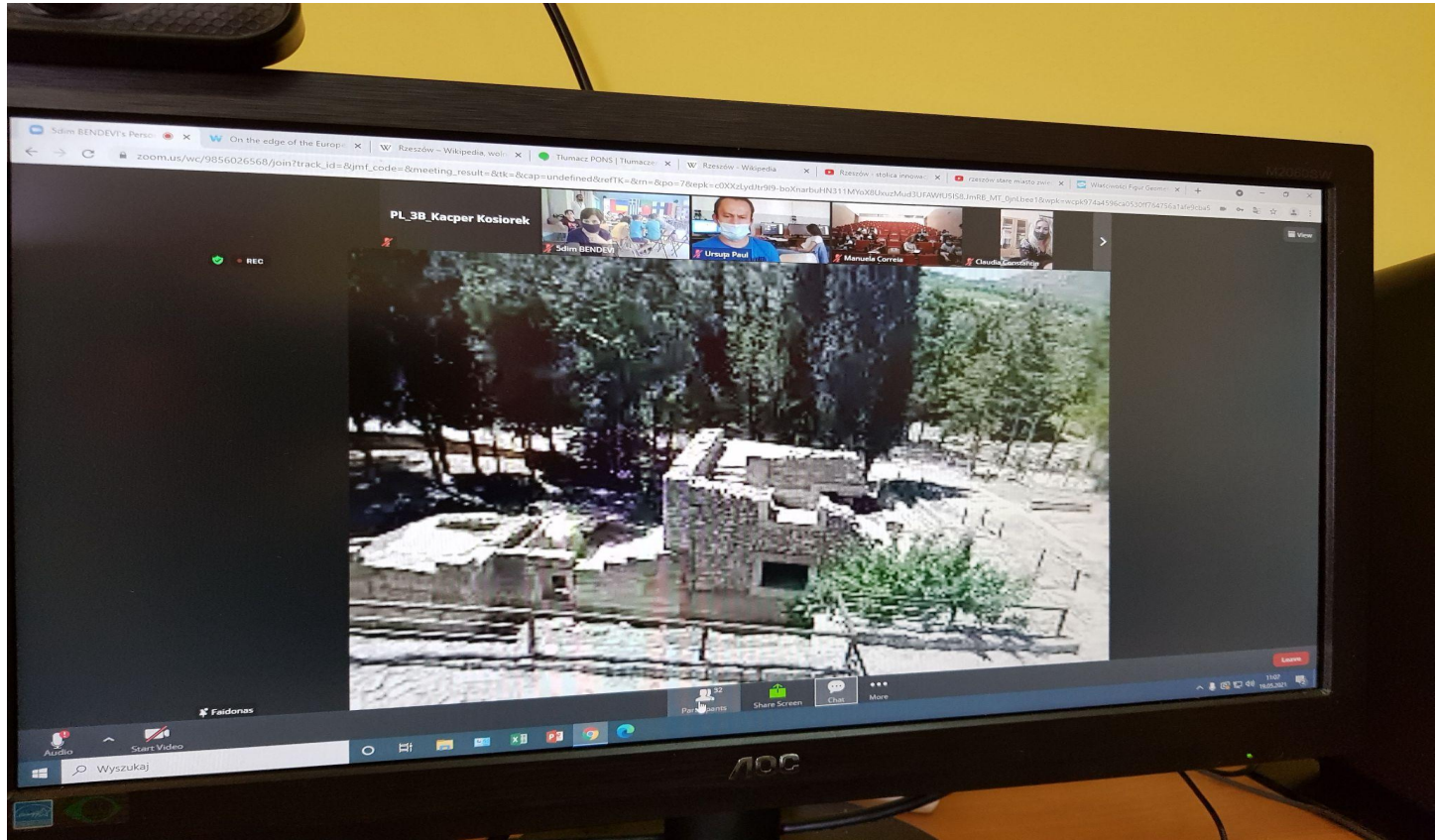

THURSDAY

On this penultimate day of the project, students learned traditional Greek instruments. They visited the museum of musical instruments and learned how to make an ancient Greek sistro instrument. Participants were also tasked that day to find the last letters and discover the password.

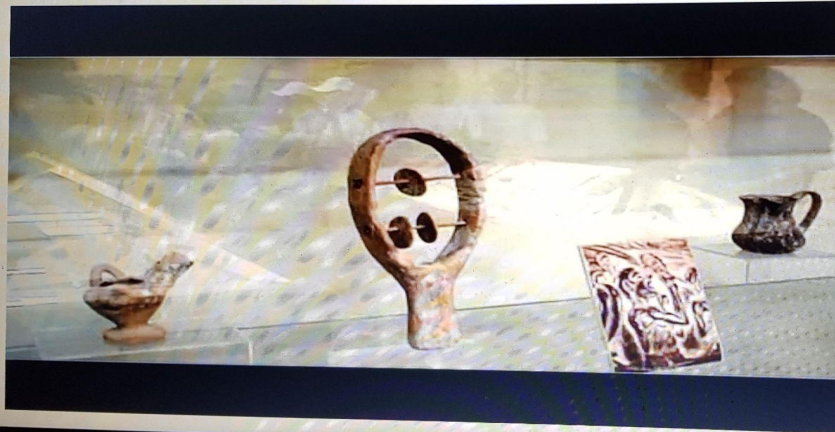

The birth of dance in Crete

The musical history of Crete begins with the birth of the father of the gods, Zeus, in the high and proud mountains of the island. The Kurites, these mythical Cretan warriors, covered the sound of the baby Zeus crying to protect him from Saturn, his father, dancing and hitting their arms loudly and rhythmically.

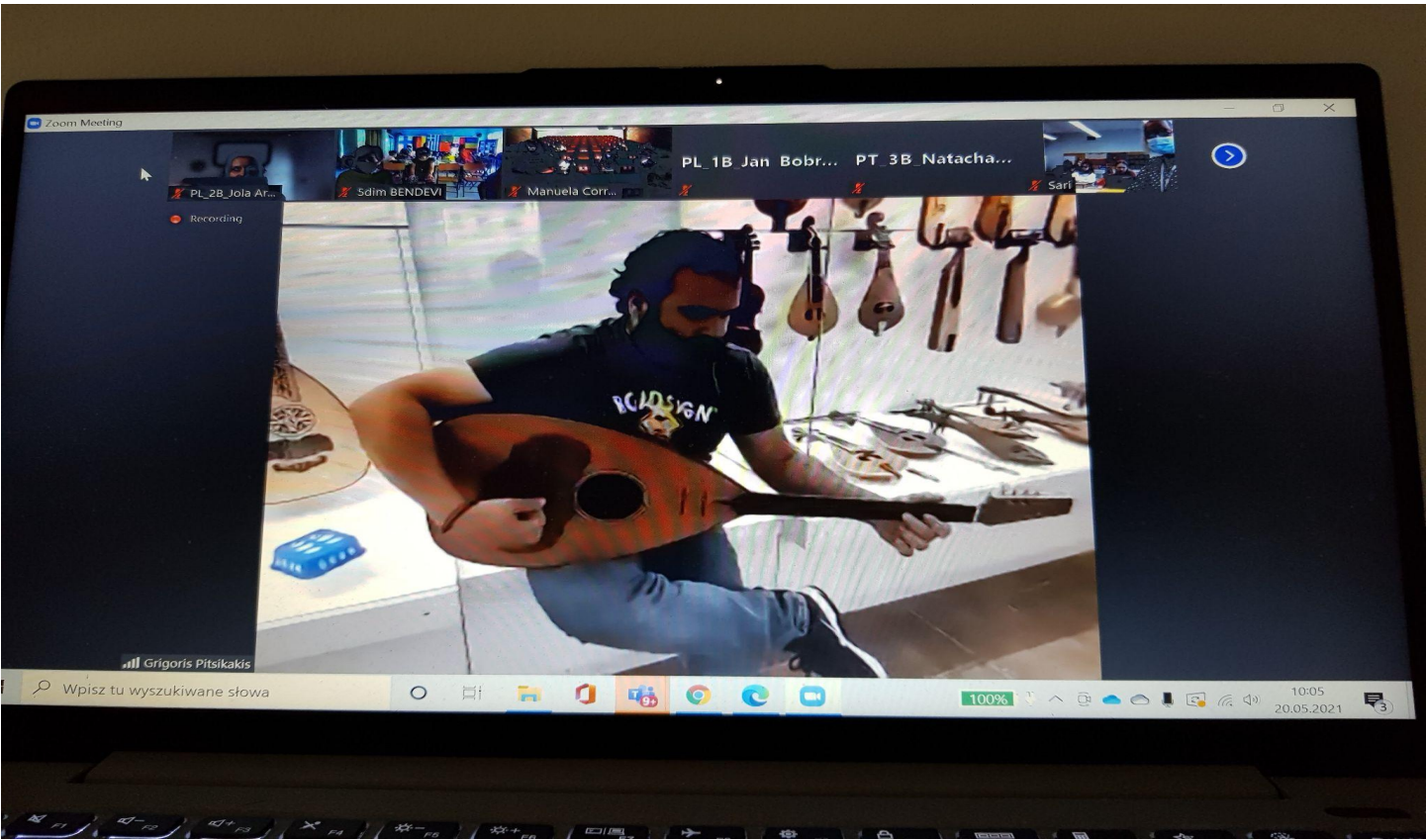
