
Ludwig van Beethoven

Ludwig van Beethoven was born in 1770 and died in 1827. Beethoven was one of the greatest pianists of his time. But when he got older, he became ill and went deaf (= he couldn't hear anymore). He then focused on composing. Even today, he's still one of the best-known and most-played composers in the world. One of his works, the 9th Symphony, is even used as the Anthem of Europe!

Mark Forster

Mark Forster was born in 1984. He is a very popular pop singer and songwriter. He started his career in 2012 and had a lot of successful singles since then. On November 16th, his newest (and 4th) album came out! He also collaborated with other popular singers and created a song for the FIFA World Cup.

He's also a jury member of the German version of the reality talent show "The Voice". In the show, he coaches young singers and helps them to start a career.

Helene Fischer


