

AMADEUS BAND (2000- present)



The band named Amadeus was founded in 2000, in Bucharest, Romania. Amadeus (also known as the Amadeus Quartet) is a vocal instrumental quartet, a musical project originating in Romania, which adopts the classic crossover and pop styles. Amadeus consists of four musicians: Andreea Runceanu (violin / voice), Bianca Gavrilescu (vocals / backing vocals), Patricia Cimpoiașu (cello / backing vocals) and Laura Andreea Lazarescu (piano / vocals / backing vocals).

Bringing a note of fresh air into the instrumental Romanian music, Amadeus performs concerts in the country and in the entire Europe. Between 2002 and 2009, Amadeus released the following albums, under the MediaPro Music production: Continental, Meridian, Freedom, The Island, 24 hours. In 2002, Amadeus concerted for the Romanian soldiers from the US military base in Afghanistan. This band performs in the opening of important events. In 2014 and 2015, Amadeus gave concerts at international events such as Horyou Village - Cannes International Film Festival, Venice Biennial Art, Caritabil St. George Lodge, Nigeria, but also to other events in Istanbul, Cairo, London, Casablanca, Sardinia, Soma Bay, Astana. In 2015, Amadeus has received the trophy *The most successful Romanian band at international level*.
