Endangeredness means that the species are in danger of disappear from the world.

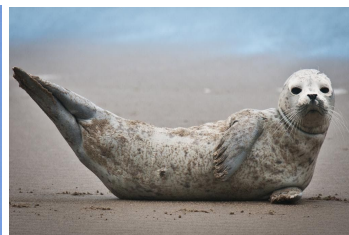
Finland's three endangered animals are arctic fox, white-tailed eagle and saimaa norp.

SAIMAA NORP

Saimaa Norp lives only in Finland. If they disappear from Saimaa, it will disappear from the whole world. That is why it is an honor for Finns to save Norp. Today they are estimated to be around 400.

Naali was a fairly large number of northern mammalian species in the 19th century, but it was almost completely eliminated by the hunt by the early 1900s. Although the nail was calmed down in Finland in 1940 and in the other Nordic countries earlier, the strain was no longer revived. The last sure sight from Finland is from 1996. However, there is hope.

In Europe, it is estimated that about 3 500 white-tailed eagle live. The white-tailed eagle is protected in Finland. It is forbidden to deliberately interfere with it, especially during the reproductive period and in resting areas. Eagle is calmed.
