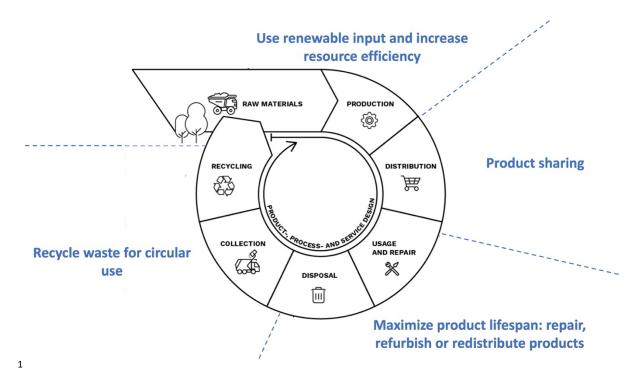


Information sheet: circular economy business models

The circular economy approach offers European start-ups broad opportunities for innovative and profitable business models. For start-up business models there are four core areas along the classic life cycle of products.



Use of renewable input and increase resource efficiency

Start-ups in this field are increasingly focusing on the first stage of the value chain and building their business model on the **use and processing of sustainable raw materials**. For example, by producing drinking straws from waste products from apple juice production or using 3D printing to create houses from sustainable materials from the environment.

Product sharing

Start-ups in this field aim to maximize the use and utilization of products over their lifetime. In their strategies, a user rents products instead of buying them, for example industrial machines, cars or everyday objects.

Maximizing product lifespan: repair, refurbish or redistribute products

Start-ups in this field pursue business models that aim to make products usable for longer. Founders, for example, have found creative ways to replace disposable products with reusable alternatives to extend their useful life ("precycling"). Platforms that can be used to

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feed products back into the cycle also belong to this category. Start-ups in this area also **take back used products to resell them** after a general refurbishment.

Recycle waste for circular use

Start-ups in this field offer business models based on the principle of recycling. Other start-ups in this area are trying to develop processes that allow materials that have already been disposed of to be reused. Upcycling is the process of transforming waste products or useless materials into products of new value.²
