Where is Pamukkale ?

Pamukkale is located to the south central of the Aegean region of Turkey.

It is about 19 km to Denizli city and a 2,5 hour drive from the resort town Kusadasi.

How to go to Pamukkale?

Denizli is the nearest city to Pamukkale. You can catch a minibus or taxi to go there from Denizli. It takes 20 minutes ride from Denizli to Pamukkale village. If you like to use the bus, there are buses to Pamukkale from almost all cities.

The nearest airport to Pamukkale is Denizli-Cardak Airport. Some airlines arrange transportation for their passengers to Pamukkale with a little cost.

What to Eat in Pamukkale ?

Karniyarık: Main ingredients are eggplants and ground beef. Eggplants is filled with ground beef and other ingredients.



Künefe: Künefe is made by Kadayıf and cheese. It served hot. The homeland of the is künefe Hatay.
