The history of the palace



Up to 1805 this historical estate was sold repeatedly to different masters and in 1805 this castle was bought by Yerzi Podolsky. He didn't have his own children and later the house was passed to his younger brother Leon. About the architecture of this local palace has been written a long time.

Leon had a lot of debts, so the house was sold together with the park. Then the castle was turned into a sugar plant. The owner of the estate was Tutus Podolsky. This palace was situated in a wide ravine and was filled by valuable furniture and family archives that were conducted since 1400.

By this beautiful castle were built a new park and two ponds. In winter 1917 the palace and his valuables were burned in the fire. All that remained is - this park, which is now the orchard and partly resembles a pine forest.
