



Are there cultural minorities?

Yes, there are cultural minorities in Portugal's community, but they are not very representative. Besides, there are programs to improve a healthy and secure community.






Do they participate freely and publicly in their culture, or are they expected to do so only privately or not at all?

Why is it important to preserve, develop and appreciate other cultures?




It's important to preserve the different types of culture. Our behaviour should be related to our culture and also to the way we express ourselves and how we act every day and not imposed by law.
