




- 1. The workshop using Genially. If the school has problems with the internet connection, shouldn't have proposed such activity 2 answers 30%

- Not enough communication between teachers from different countries 2 answers 29%
- 1 The polish students didn't participate in the visits. 2 The polish works about Solidarity were not presented. 3 - The Polish Coordinator didn't assist to the presentations of the students' works and didn't go to the visits. 4 - It was not pleasant that we had to go and buy the tickets to the salt mines and we had to go there twice because there was no reservation. 5 - It was not pleasant to have to go to a bus stop and buy the tickets for all students at a machine, without knowing what kind of ticket to buy. 6 - it was very unpleasant to have to go on a bus full of people with all the students to the mines. This was not safe, because, with so many people on the bus, we couldn't control them.- 2 answers - 29%
