




WELCOME TO CYPRUS

A flag so simple in design, but at the same time so important for the Cypriot people that they made so many sacrifices to obtain it.


The white color is a symbol of freedom and purity while the orange-yellow color symbolizes the copper that was abundant in the old days on the island.

Since 1974 the northern part of Cyprus is under Turkish occupation. About 200000 people were forced to leave their homes and move to the southern part of the island and are still refugees in their own homeland.





the Eurozone**



promoting him as the first of four doctors who stood out with




Pavlos Kontides is a Cypriot sailor, He became the first Cypriot athlete ever to win an Olympic medal
