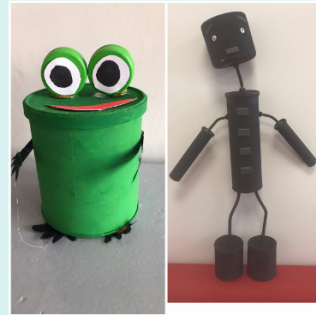
A story:

They turned the rice to an omelette, so in this way we can prevent wasting of food.

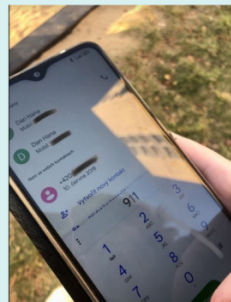
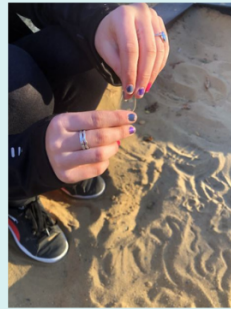
