1st Day

As part of this mobility, on the first day, teachers and students from Greece and Bulgaria met at the IES Punta del Verde school where we were welcomed by the Spanish partners. The first contact and acquaintance was pleasant, followed by a presentation of the work of each country. The Greek students presented the results of their own research, on "Air Quality and Recycling of Electrical and Electronic Devices" followed by an exchange of views based on comparative studies





Conclusions were drawn regarding the reduction of air pollutants during the quarantine due to pandemic, no worrying increase was observed during the summer months due to tourist traffic while an increase of pollutants occurred during the winter months due to the use of heating media. This was followed by a tour of the impressive Alcazar Palace in Seville, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the Cathedral, where we got in touch with the history and culture of the city.

2nd Day

On the second day we visited the Recilec factory for the Recycling of electrical and electronic equipment, where the Public Relations Officer presented in detail the stages of the process of recycling and reuse of materials. The program continued with a visit and stay in the picturesque village of Galaroza. In the traditional house La casa la serreria we were hosted and tasted traditional dishes, in the preparation of which we all participated with great enthusiasm. All participants were given the opportunity to develop closer relationships, largely achieving the interaction that is the goal of such practices.



3rd Day

The third day began with a hike in the park Sierra de Aracena Y picos de Aroche, where we enjoyed nature, got to know the history of the place and had an unforgettable experience of contact with the natural environment. This was followed by an experiential workshop on the waste of energy from electrical appliances and the dramatization by students of the unwise behavior of consumers through a humorous look.





4th Day

Next destination was the area of Aracena which we approached after a 5 km hike in a forest area. We tasted traditional products of the area and visited the famous Cave of Miracles (Gruta de las Maravillas) known for the stalactite formations, stalagmites and columns that created a whole world that the persistence of water, stone and time have shaped so that the human imagination can feel the exact magnitude of nature. It was a life experience for all participants.



5th Day

On the last day, teachers and students gathered at the school where the certificates were awarded and the students were asked to record their impressions and feelings from the whole process. In a warm and moving atmosphere we made an appointment for our next meeting. All students said they were excited by the experience but also very sensitive to issues such as air pollution, recycling and reuse of materials.



During our five-day stay in Spain we had the opportunity to exchange conclusions based on air quality studies and experiences that highlight the importance and value of implementing such European training programs.
