Will

a) spontaneous decision

b) not sure (90%)

c) adverb - I'll probably come.

Maybe I'll come

Most likely I'll stay at home.

Possibly I'll go...

If all goes well, I'll go to uni...

If I'm tired,

If I feel good,

The chances are ... I'll ...

For sure, I'll stay in tonight.

- I might go ... (50%)

Future continuous

- answer the question:

A: Do you fancy having a coffee tomorrow at 11?

B: I can't, because I'll be having a lesson (I'll be studying).

(hodinu ma'm od 9¹⁵ do 12⁰⁰ - její děj probíhá v této době → future continuous)

x I'm having a lesson at 9¹⁵ (zde je ^{dan} určitý bod)

Future perfect (dreams) → finished

- By + time

By the time I'm 50, I'll have got promoted.

(hopefully if all goes to plan) become the Head.
