Target group: pupils

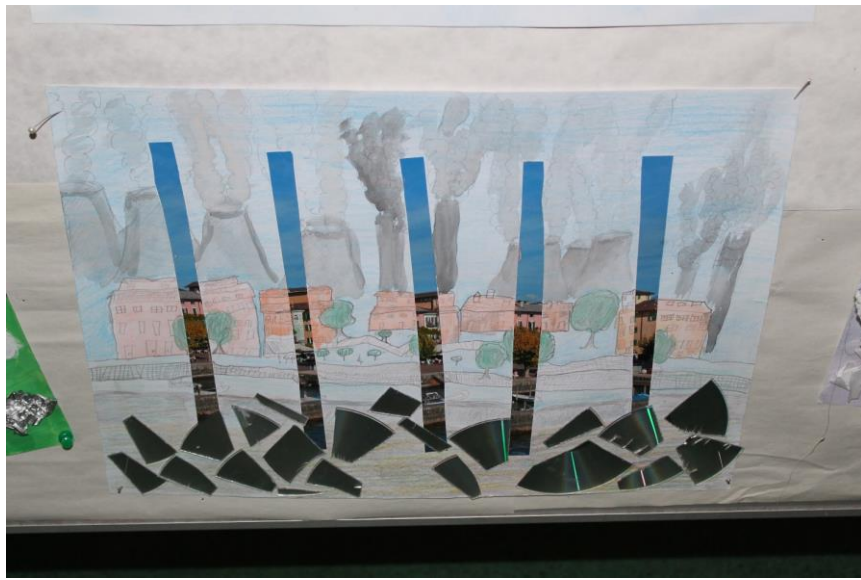
Methods:

5. Discussion and connection to SD.



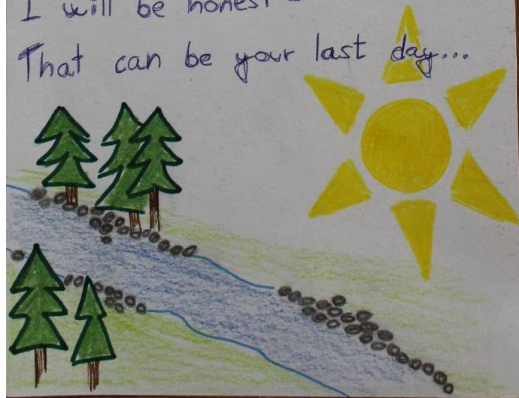

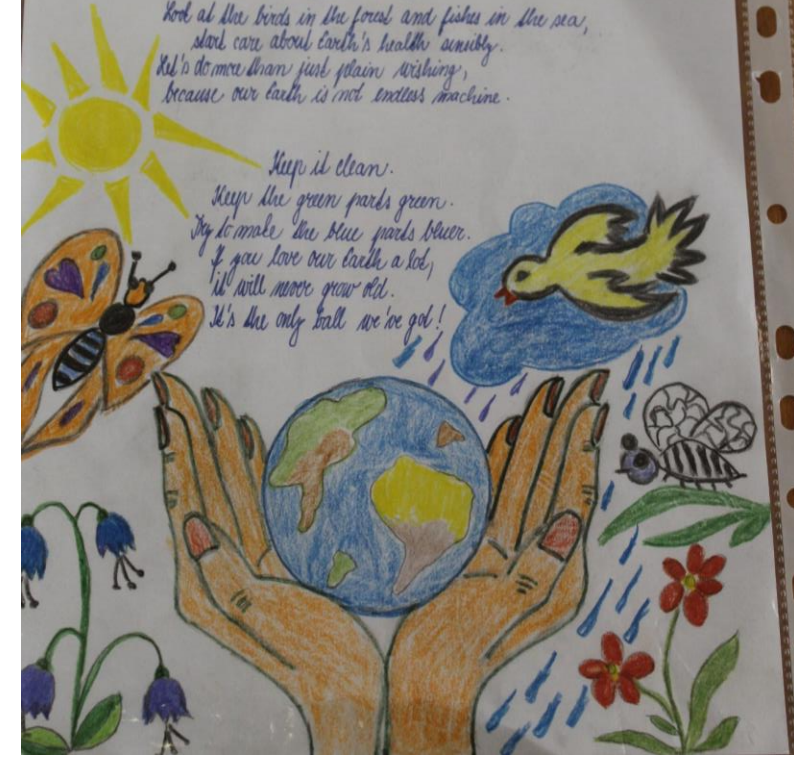
OUR HOME

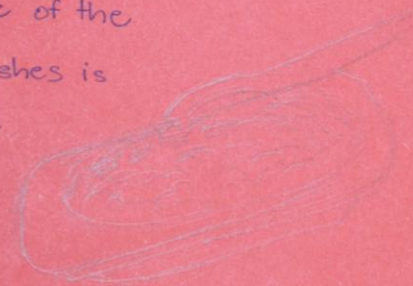
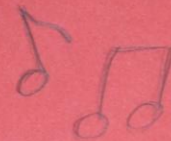

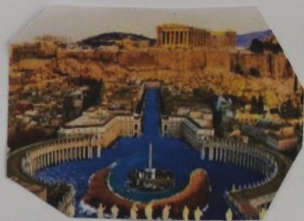
The capital of Greece is Athens. The official language speak in Greece is Greek, speak by 99% of the population.

ANTONIO VIVALDI:

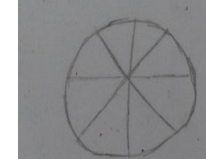
