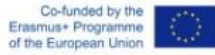

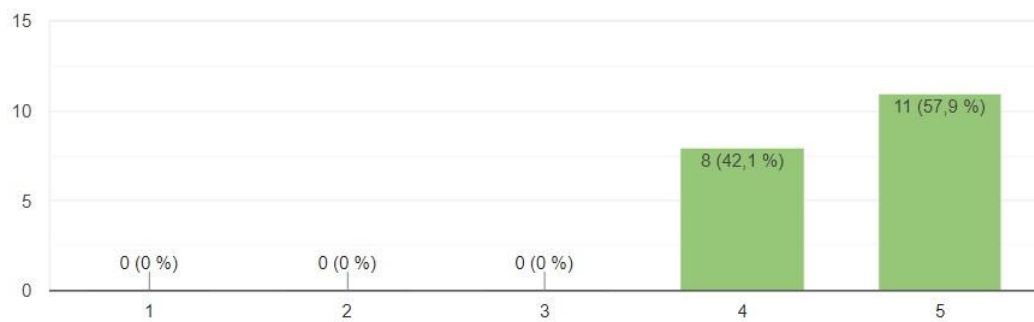

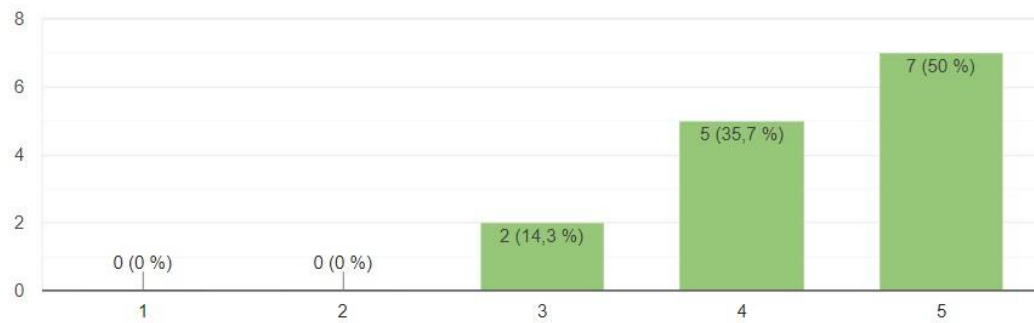
1. Taking part in this Erasmus+ Project has generally proved worthwhile for me

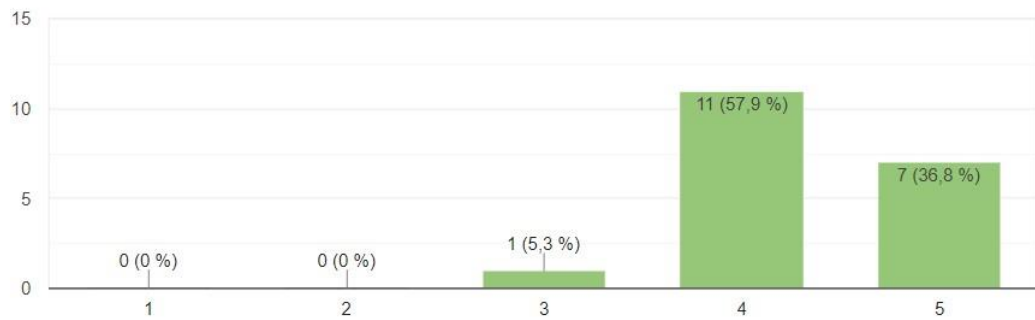
2. Taking part in some of the Teachers courses has proved worthwhile for me

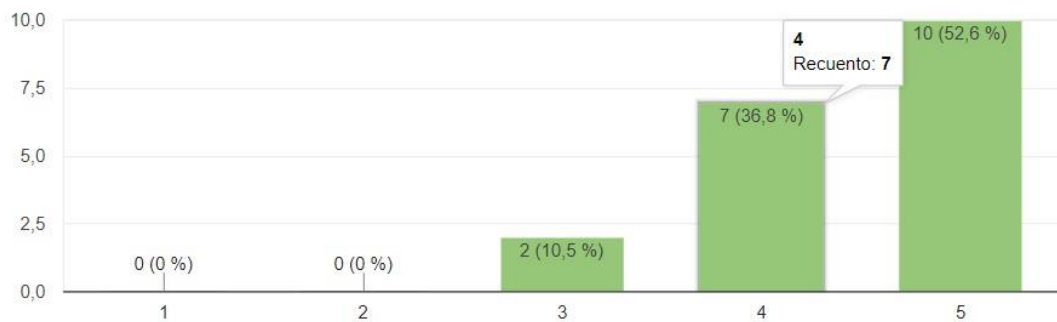

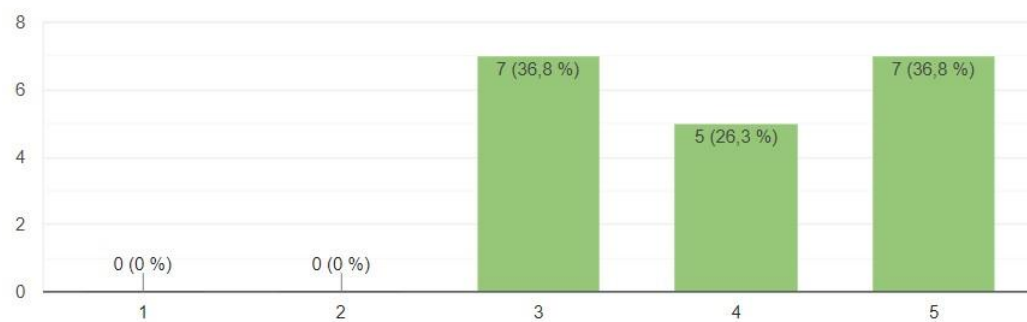
