



I. GENERAL IMPACT


1. Taking part in this Erasmus+ Project has generally proved worthwhile for me.


2. My abilities of communicating in the English language have improved.


3. My digital skills have improved.


4. Taking part in the virtual transnational learning activities has helped my awareness of Portuguese culture.


5. My attitude towards the European Union has improved.


6. Due to my participation in this project, my understanding of or my skills in one or more school subjects has/have improved.


7. I am more aware about sustainable development and plan to have a more active role about it.

8. Taking part in this project has helped me to make career choices.




9. In general, the Virtual Activities were clear, stimulating and interesting.


10. The TwinMotion Workshop was stimulating and motivating for the next project phase.
