

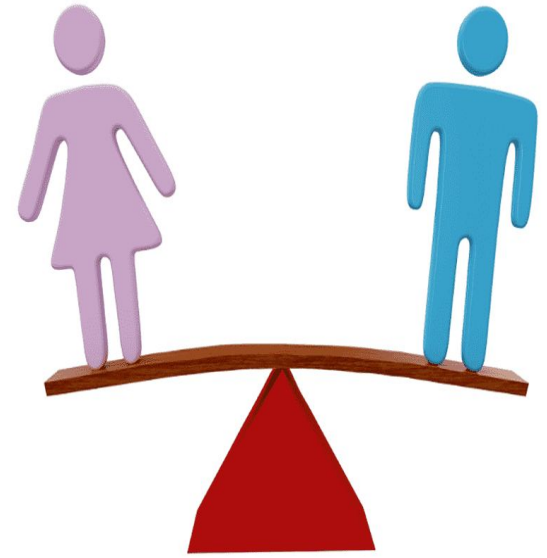

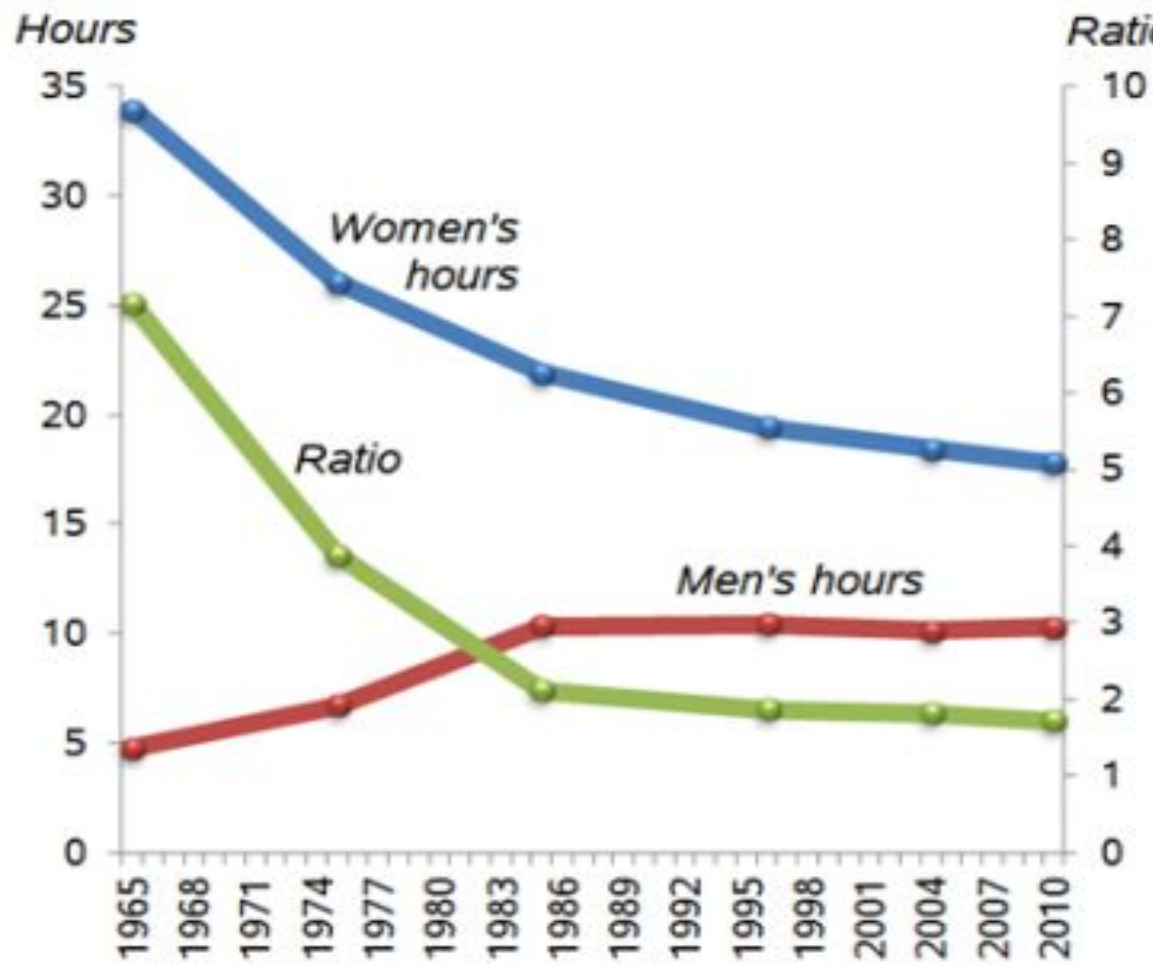

GENDER INEQUALITIES IN FAMILY ARE AN ISSUE IN SPAIN BECAUSE...

Gender inequality in the family is a problem in our country because the concept that a child develops about male and female gender is strongly influenced by the environment around him or her. Gender stereotypes are culturally transmitted, learned and incorporated into our knowledge. Thus, from birth we learn to behave according to the gender to which we belong in order to be accepted by our parents, relatives, friends... in other words, by society.

In order to work on equality within the family, it is necessary to take into account the values that are transmitted to children. To do this, it is necessary to promote respect, value feelings, promote games and activities that are free of sexist content... since, in this way, each boy or girl will develop a vision of reality based on their tastes and preferences and not on the basis of their gender.

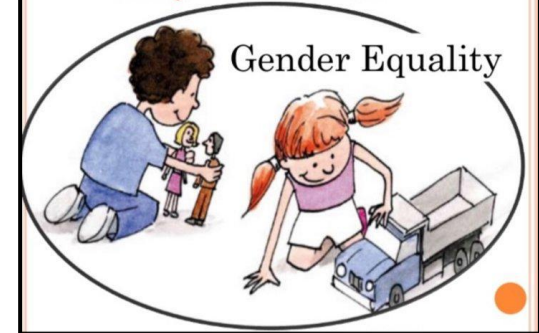

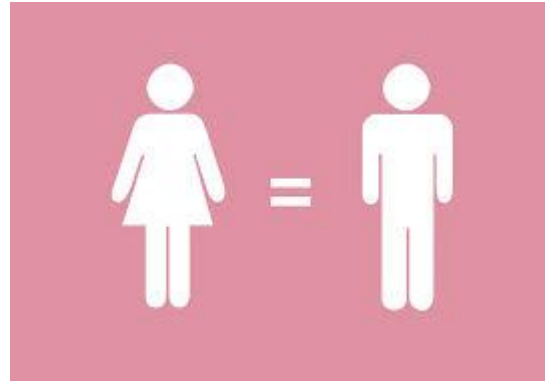

One of the victims of gender inequalities in our country was Carmina Ordoñez; which was a socialite, model and Spanish public relations protagonist of the national heart pres.

She was one of the first public figures to report mistreatment on television by her third husband. The judge did not admit the complaint against her husband, Ernesto Neyra, because he considered that "he did not meet the sociological profile of an abused woman."



TO WHAT EXTENT HAVE THE SOCIAL NETWORKS/MEDIA FOCUSED ON THIS ISSUE?

This problem of gender inequality has been around forever and was much stronger before. The evolution of this problem has a lot to do with social media as it has helped a lot. Many women suffer inequalities every day and thanks to the speed of social networks they are publicly denounced. People seeing that so many women suffer from this have realized that it is a very common problem and have tried to find solutions. In our country, as in many others, as is normal, they also organize demonstrations, petitions campaigns, and flashmobs to support the reduction of gender inequalities. Among them, every March 8, which is International Women's Day, And on November 25, the international day for the elimination of violence against women, demonstrations are prepared to reveal the rights of women.

As for the campaigns, the government of the country has organized a campaign with the slogan "we stop sexist violence united." This campaign was launched as a contingency plan against Gender Violence in the face of the COVID19 crisis.

Continuing with the campaigns, precisely in the Basque country they have created a campaign with the name "beldur barik" (for the International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women), which is a program in favor of equality and against gender violence. Through him they prepare a competition for people between 12 and 26 years old with the aim of creating audiovisual productions that reflect how girls and boys respond to situations of inequality and how they deal with sexist violence.
