- sometimes **lack of cooperation**

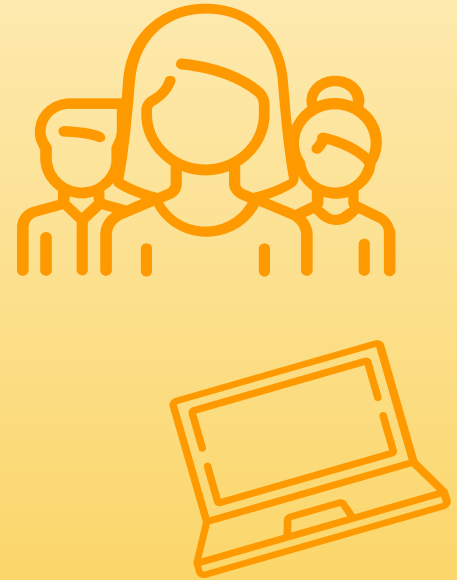
# Conclusion

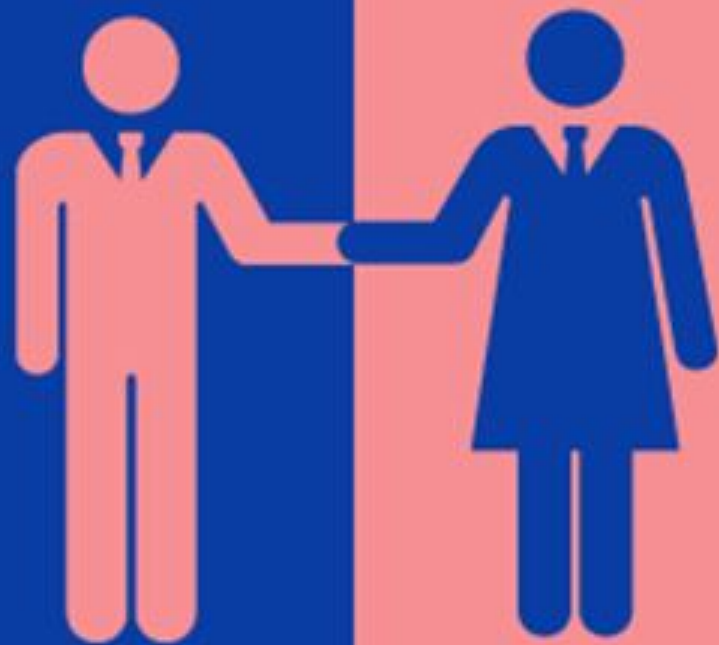
I would not hesitate to recommend the project because it was really useful.
