2) Does being a woman or a man matter in the Netherlands?

Not so long ago, men and women's roles in the Netherlands were firmly divided along traditional gender lines, with men at the head of the family. Women automatically lost their job as soon as they took their marriage vows.

Women are more often victims of serious violence and more often violated and injured. Almost three times as many women report being injured in an argument with a partner. Women are also more often victims of sexual violence (more than 1 in 5 women, compared to 1 in 11 men). Thus, women experience more and more severe violence than men, and their partner's control of their lives is usually much greater.

Compared to other EU countries, the Netherlands earns high marks for gender equality within family.
