## "For recycling"

It's made out of multiple layers of recycled plastic.

It's made to be reused and brought to the stores, to prevent customers from buying plastic bags



### Less plastic

As you can see, Coop is only using the amount of plastic, that they need.

Plastic is only used for the steak - not for the rest of the package.

But, as they say themselves "Using little plastic is still using plastic".



# A bargain

This perfectly fine cod-fillet has been reduced in price with 25% because of its expiry date.


They usually reduce the price of food which expiry date is soon.



### TooGoodToGo

"Too good to go" does exactly what it's stating. You can buy food that won't be used or sold in the restaurants, stores, cafes etc.

Sometimes, there will be a discount of 75%. The supermarket we visited also made use of TooGoodToGo.



## Recycling system

In Denmark we have a very well working recycling system.

The waste collectors arrive at supermarkets, where they transport the sorted trash to a power plant, where the trash is being transformed into energy.
