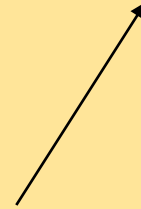

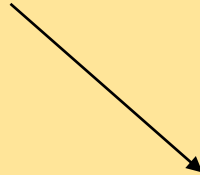

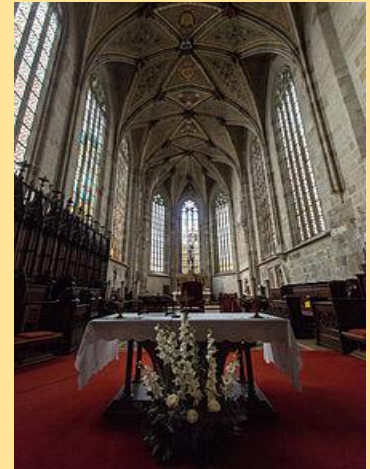

Cathedral of Saint Martin

It is located on the western edge of the Old City, under the castle of Bratislava. The Cathedral of St. Martin was known in the past especially for having hosted, between 1563 and 1830, the coronations of the rulers of Hungary. The construction of the Cathedral was carried out from the fourteenth century, on a site previously occupied by a Romanesque church and a cemetery. In 1452 the Cathedral was consecrated, but the work of completion of the work continued in the following centuries.

Grassalkovich palace

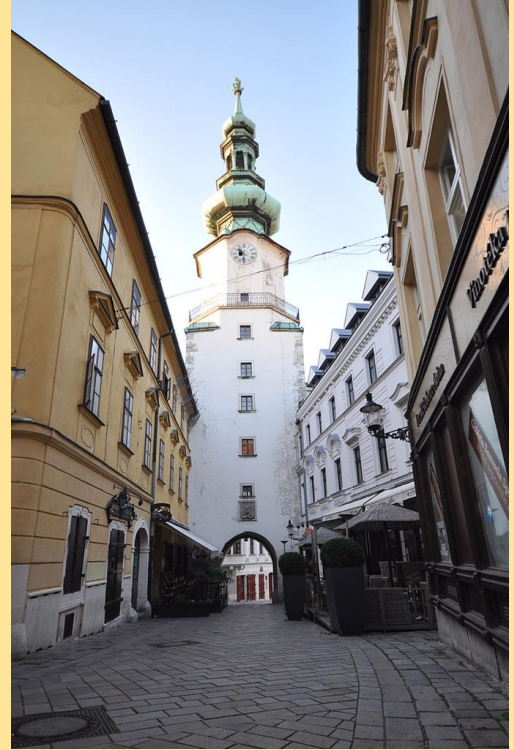
Church of Saint Elizabeth

St. Michael's Gate is the only city gate in Bratislava, Slovakia, left standing and ranks among the oldest buildings in the city.

...Let's celebrate Carnival!

In the morning we are celebrating the Slovak Carnival!! The traditional carnival in Slovakia is defined with the word "fašiangy". The culmination of the Fasiangy celebrations in Slovakia is between the last Sunday before Lent on Shrove Tuesday, at midnight, but it can also extend until the following morning.

The consumption of huge quantities of food and alcoholic beverages was an integral part of fašiangy, and in the past women cooked meat in the oven, pork jelly, fried sisky (stuffed pasta) or pampuchy (a sort of potato pancake). Many also put these cooked foods on the graves of their deceased.

And a great theatrical event was staged on the streets of villages and towns. Groups of masked youths and extravagant costumes passed from house to house playing music.

of 18,00€



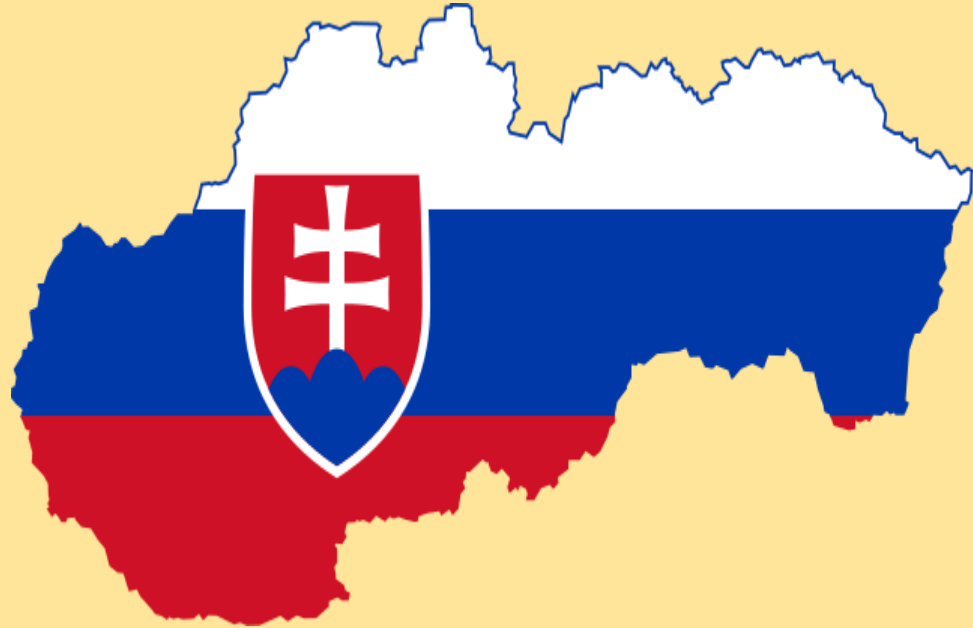
