1. ANCHOVY

- Lives in herds.
- Grows up to 18 centimeters.
- Most hunted in Peru.
- Approaches the beaches to feed from January To March.
- Has no lower lip.
- Can live as deep as 400 meters.
- Longest recorded life span is 5 years.



2. WHITING



- Average 20-40 centimeters in size.
- Common in the atlantic ocean.
- Lives 30-40 meters deep in the sea.
- Usually their height is 50 centimeters and their weight is 2 kilograms.
- They are in shades of yellow and brown.
- They are long and thin in appearance.

3. PERCH



- Their lifespan is 20 years on average.
- They breed between January and March.
- Often feed on shrimp , crab and tiny worms.
- They prefer dark and secluded areas of water to live.
- It is seen that their average length of 50-60 centimeters sometimes increases to 1 meter.

4. BONITO



- Bonito fish that live and migrate in flocks live and migrate in flocks live in warm and hot seas.
- They are predatory and aggressive fish that can swim quickly.
- It is a fish with large and long teeth without scales and flesh black.
- The average length of these fish is up to 90 centimeters.

5. HORSE MACKEREL

- The body of these fish is slightly flattened from the sides.
- Their mouths can be extended forward.
- Their tails are deeply forked.
- Their teeth are pearl eyes big.
- Height is between 20-30 centimeters.
- They live in droes.
