

City game

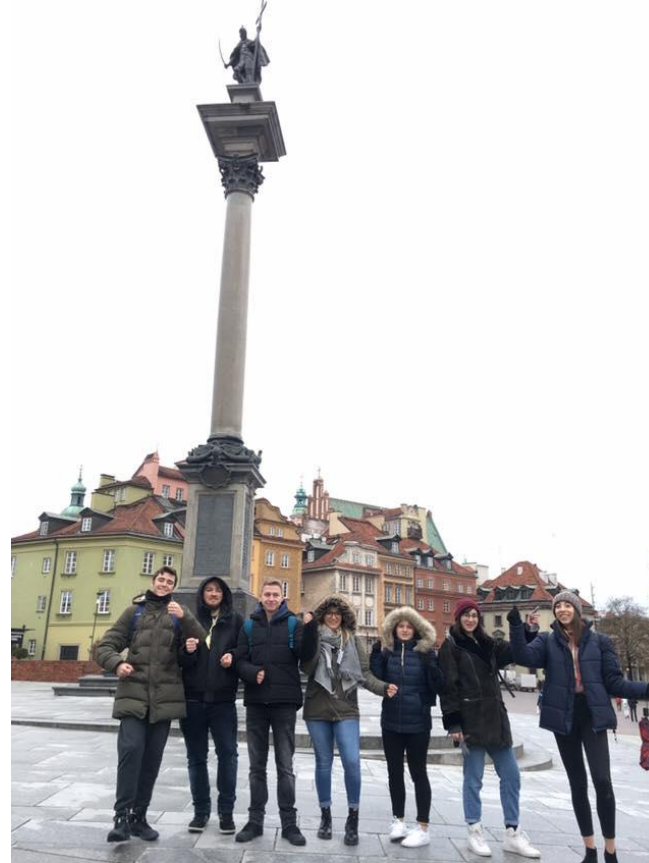
We divided the students into international groups and went around Warsaw to finish the tasks we got handed out.
