



Regarding the evaluation / implementation of the meeting, the evaluation is above 4 "I agree", and the highlight is the "opportunity for interaction between partners" and the fact that "allows participants to know each other". The question with the lowest score (4.3) was "the opportunity to exchange teaching experiences". 

Graph 3 - Impact of the meeting

On the impact of the meeting, the rating is above 4 "I agree", and the highlight is the "increase of knowledge about the visited country", "approximation of the European spirit, promoting tolerance and mutual understanding" and the fact "enable knowledge between countries and cultures". The question with the lowest score (2,4) was "computer skills". There are a few questions that scored 3 / Agree with reservations or a lower score: language, computer skills, pedagogical, motivation and project management skills.

In the two open-ended questions, we tried to group by categories in order to avoid a dispersion of the results. Thus, in the first question "expectations of the meeting in Portugal" the main categories are: learn / know more about Portugal (culture, hospitality), learn / know about migration and globalization, contact with colleagues from other countries, exchange of experiences (pedagogical skills, computer skills, improving English skills, migration, European Union). In the second question, "improvements for future meetings" the answers were grouped as follows: improve time management and flow of program information, make better use of e-twinning / twinspace (information, meeting preparation, communication between all more money for the project, on the first day there are fewer activities and better program organization.







DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSIONS

In order to produce an analysis of the data described above, an analysis table can be used which is used in organizations and can be translated into adjustments for any entity / team.

For a brief explanation, when a value of 5 is obtained, it means that the cycle is complete and has gone perfectly, and it can be repeated that it will succeed. When you get the value 1, it means it was poorly planned and you have to redesign the process.

Overall the meeting in Portugal, obtained an AVERAGE of 4.3. According to the table, program adjustments (preparation and implementation) should be made. The vast majority of questions were rated positively, however, when there are some questions with low score answers, although AVERAGE is higher, but it shows that some people for some reason were not satisfied and feel that the item in question could be better. Thus stands out:

- preparation of the meeting "the information given by the Portuguese team was sufficient"; "the information was provided in a timely manner";
- evaluation / implementation of the meeting "the opportunity to exchange didactic experiences"; "the
 objectives of each activity were clearly defined"; "the program was adequate"; "the planned program has
 been reached"; "opportunity to exchange teaching experiences";
- impact of the meeting "on computer skills"; "language skills / abilities"; "informatics, pedagogical, motivation and project management";
- open-ended questions: "expectations of the meeting in Portugal" learn / know more about Portugal (culture, hospitality), learn / know about migration and globalization, contact with colleagues from other countries, exchange of experiences (pedagogical skills, informatics, improving English skills, migration, European Union); "upcoming match enhancements" improving time management and flow of program information, making better use of e-twinning / twinspace (information, meeting preparation, communication between all teams), more money for the project in the first less activities and better program organization.

To finish this review is quoted a foreign colleague who says "I had a lot of expectations about this meeting, because I know the Portuguese team is very powerful and i was right ..."
