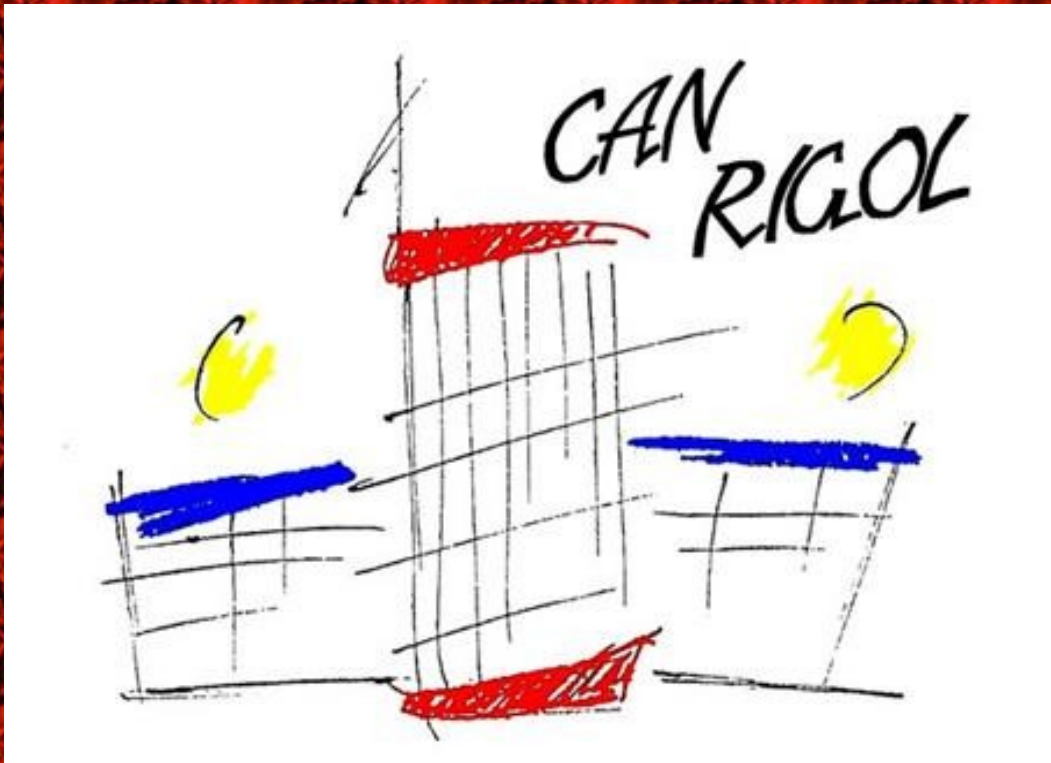

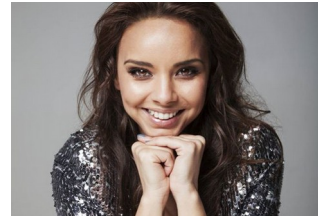

## ART AND MONUMENTS

### GAUDÍ AND LA SAGRADA FAMÍLIA



- Designed by Antoni Gaudí (Reus 1852- Barcelona 1926) it is a Catholic religious temple, but also an artistic symbol in Barcelona.

- Start of construction: 1882, currently still under construction. They think finish in 2026.

- It is the greatest exponent of Catalan Modernism and the most visited monument in Spain (3,2 million visitants).

## THE APRIL FAIR OF CATALONIA

The April Fair of Catalonia, (Feria de abril de Cataluña), is an annual event held in the Catalan capital of Barcelona, Spain. It usually takes place over the last week of April and the first week of May. In 1971, immigrants to Barcelona from Andalusia, and their descendants, began their own version of the Seville Fair, Feria de abril de Sevilla. Since then the Barcelona event has grown to become the second largest Spring Fair in Spain.

A major difference between the Barcelona and Seville events is that the casetas in Barcelona are completely open to the public. In the casetas, food and drink are served, people either dance on dance floors, or are entertained by musical performances, usually by flamenco dancers and singers.
