➤ **Type of the activity** : Didactic game

➤ **Title:** Describing people.

➤ **Aims of the activity:**

To reinforce English skills through play.

To describe people .

To practice adjective order.

To practice the verb have got.

To incentive the cooperative working.

To accept the rules of the game.

➤ **Description of the activity:**

This is a guessing game for 2 players (or teams). The game is played using a game board and one of six sets of playing cards. In this game, there is one person asking questions (Player Q) and the other person answering questions (Player A). According to the given answers, Player Q eliminates the pictures on the game board until he or she finds out the secret set.

variation

The game can also be played on two boards, one for each player. Each player marks his or her secret set of cards, then tries to guess the other person's set by process of elimination.

You need:

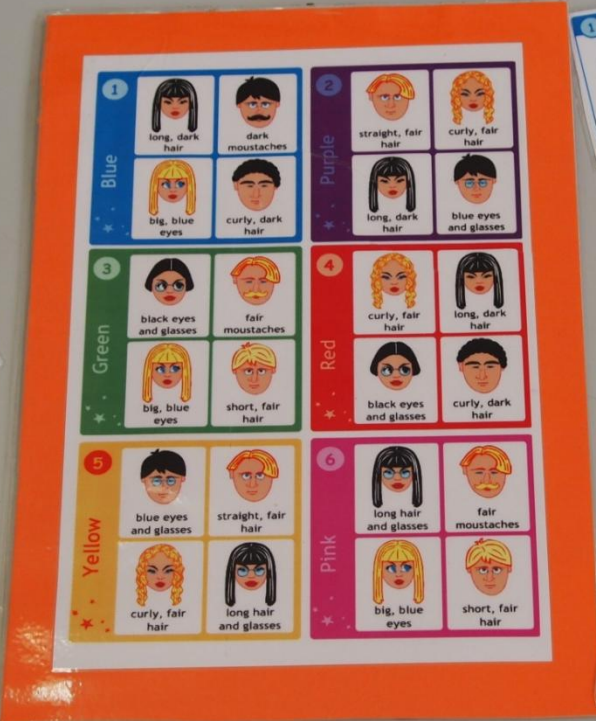
A game board for player Q, 6 set of playing cards, an envelope for each set of cards

➤ **RULES:**

1. Decide who will be the player Q and player A.
2. Player Q gets the game board. Player A select an envelope, takes out the cards and fans them in his or her hand secretly.
3. Player Q has to guess the secret by asking yes/no questions.
4. According to the given answers , Player Q eliminates the pictures on his/her game board until he /she finds out the secret set.

For example: Player Q: Has he got fair moustache?

Player A: No, he hasn't.





Blue	1	long, dark hair	dark moustaches

DESCRIBING PEOPLE

a guessing game played with a Board and Cards

This is a game for 2 players for 2 teams played with a game board and six sets of playing cards (each in its envelope). In this game, there is one person asking questions (Player Q) and the other person answering questions (Player A). Before the game, revise or pre-teach the vocabulary used in the activity.

Rules

- Decide who will be Player Q and Player A.
- Player Q gets a game board. Player A selects an envelope, takes out the cards and fans them in his or her hand secretly.
- Player Q has to guess the secret set by asking yes/no questions. According to the given answers, Player Q eliminates the pictures on his/her game board until he or she finds out the secret set.

for example

Player A's secret set

Player Q: Has he got fair moustaches?
 Player A: No, he hasn't.
 Player A hasn't got number 3 and 6.

Player Q: Has he got curly, dark hair?
 Player A: Yes, he has.
 Player A has got number 1 or 4.

Player Q: Has she got black eyes and glasses?
 Player A: No, she hasn't.
 Player A hasn't got number 4.

Player Q: You have got number 1!

You need

- a game board for Player Q
- 6 sets of playing cards
- an envelope for each card set

Preparation

Print out a game board and sets of playing cards. If you want, you can stick every printout onto card. Cut out the individual cards, fold them and glue. You can laminate your game board and cards for future use.











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
