>Type of the activity: Didactic game

≻Title: Opposite Race.

>Aims of the activity:

To reinforce English skills through play.

To learn adjectives.

To practice chosen words and opposites.

To incentive the cooperative working.

To accept the rules of the game.



> Description of the activity:

This is a game for 2-4 players (or teams). Kids take a turn by flipping a coin and move their markers around the board. When they land on a square with the happy face, they take a card, then read the word and find the opposite.

Before playing the game revise or pre-teach the vocabulary used in the activity. To do this, you can use question cards as flashcards.

You need:

A game board, a set of playing cards, a coin, a place market for each player or team.



≻How to play

- 1. Shuffle the question cards and put in a pile face down.
- 2. Take a turn by flipping a coin: head= move one space; tails= move two spaces.
- 3. When you land on a square with the happy face, you take a card from the top of the pile, read the question and find the opposite.
- 4. If you are right ,don't move. If you are wrong, move back one space.

The winner is the first player tom reach the finish.























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
