➤ **Type of the activity** : Didactic game

➤ **Title:** Let's go shopping.

➤ **Aims of the activity:**

To reinforce English skills through play.

To practice names of shops and products.

To ask and answer where you can buy an item.

To incentive the cooperative working.

To accept the rules of the game.

➤ **Description of the activity:**

This is a quizz game for 4 players (or teams). Kids move their markers around the board, answering questions as they go. There are 3 kinds of question cards: yellow - easy, green - medium and blue - difficult questions. Each player has a different marker.

Before playing the game revise or pre-teach the vocabulary used in the activity. To do this, you can use question cards as flashcards.

You need:

A game board ,a score board, question cards, a coin, a place market for each player or team

➤ How to play

1. Put the question cards in three pile (a yellow pile, a green pile, and a blue pile) face down.
2. Take a turn by flipping a coin: head= move one space ; tails= move two spaces.
3. When you land on :

a yellow square, pick up a card from the yellow pile and answer the question.
Each correct answer gains one yellow point.

a green square , pick up a card from the green pile and answer the question.
Each correct answer gains two green points.

a blue square , pick up a card from the blue pile and answer the question.
Each correct answer gains three blue points.

- 4.-If you are right, do not move . Write down your score. At the end of the game , add them up for your total . If you are wrong move back one space.
- 5.- The player with the highest score is the winner.

LET'S GO SHOPPING!

a quiz game played with a board and question cards

This is a game for 4 players (or for 4 teams). There are 3 levels of question cards: yellow - easy, green - medium and blue - difficult. Each player has a different marker. Before playing the game review or pre-teach the vocabulary used in the activity. To do this, you can use question cards as flashcards.

Rules

- Put question cards in three piles (a yellow pile, a green pile, and a blue pile) face down.
- Take a turn by flipping a coin (heads = move 1 space; tails = move 2 spaces).
- When you land on:
 - a yellow square, pick up a card from the yellow pile, read a question and answer it. Each correct answer gains one yellow point.
 - a green square, pick up a card from the green pile, read a question and answer it. Each correct answer gains two green points.
 - a blue square, pick up a card from the blue pile, read a question and answer it. Each correct answer gains three blue points.
- If you are right, don't move. Write down your score. At the end of the game, add them up for your total score.
- If you are wrong, move back one space.

The player with the highest score is the winner.

- question cards
- a coin
- a place marker for each player
