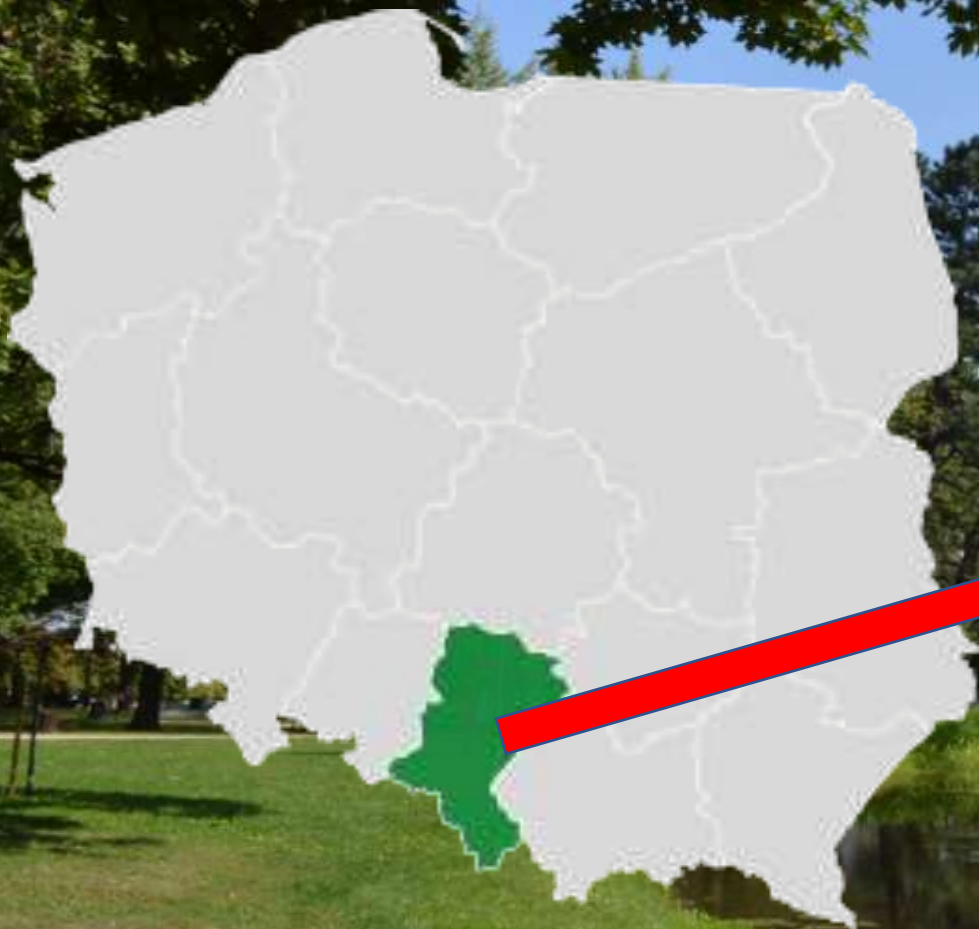

# Geographical location of Czestochowa



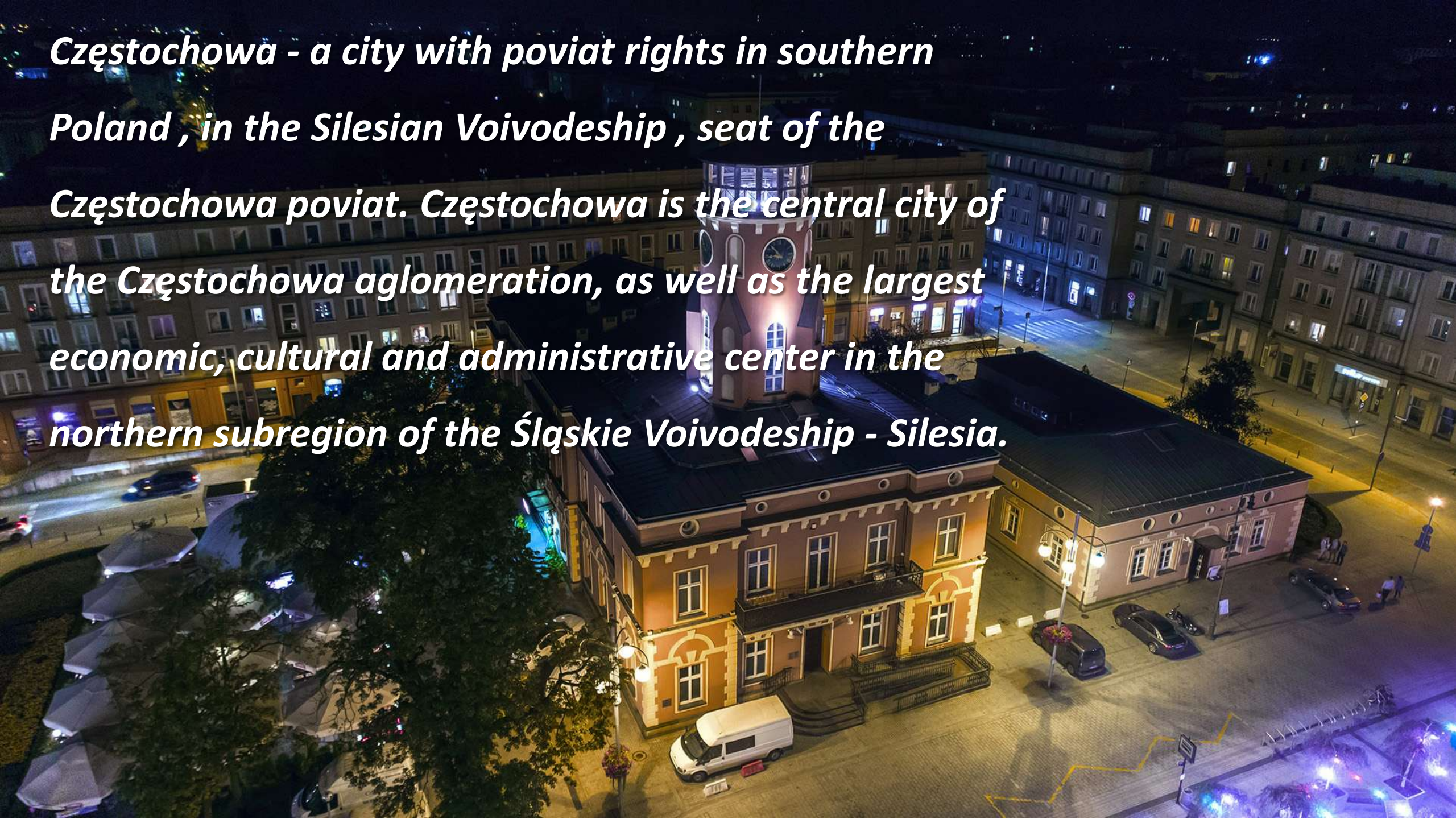

***Częstochowa - a city with powiat rights in southern Poland , in the Silesian Voivodeship , seat of the Częstochowa powiat. Częstochowa is the central city of the Częstochowa agglomeration, as well as the largest economic, cultural and administrative center in the northern subregion of the Śląskie Voivodeship - Silesia.***





# Jasna Góra

*Jasna Góra is a sanctuary and the monastery of the Pauline convent in Częstochowa, located on a hill. The beginning of the monastery is dated to 1382.*













# Avenue of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Częstochowa

*It is a street in Częstochowa , which is the main, representative artery of the city center. The avenue was established at the beginning of the 19th century, as a road connecting Old Częstochowa and New Częstochowa.*







# 7 Kamienic Street

*7 Kamienic Street - one of the historic streets in Częstochowa, located in the immediate vicinity of Jasna Góra. It is about 600 meters long and surrounds Jasna Góra from the south.*



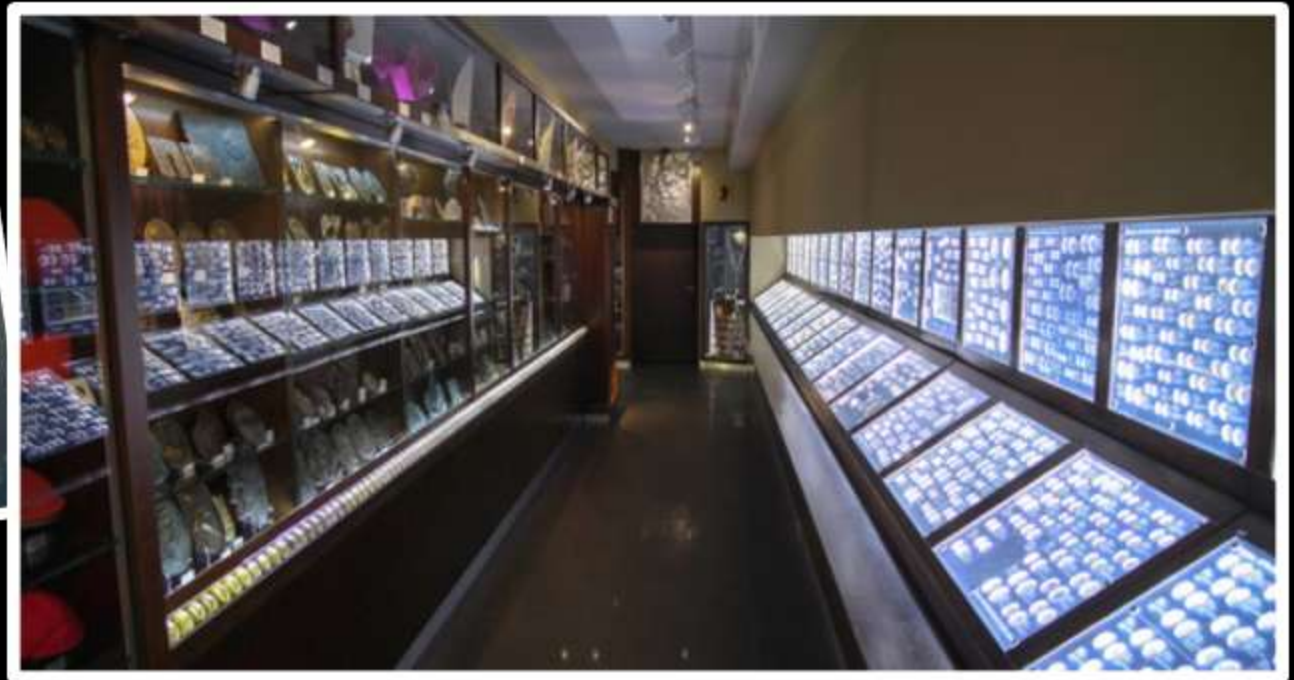




# Museum of coins and medals of St. John Paul II

*Museum of coins and medals of John Paul II in Częstochowa - a private museum in Częstochowa , founded in August 2011 on the initiative of the businessman and philanthropist Krzysztof Witkowski from Częstochowa. The museum's collections mainly contain coins and medals with the image of Pope John Paul II. It is the largest collection of this type in the world .*












# Matches Production Museum in Częstochowa

*It has exhibitions: in two exhibition halls and in a functioning production plant - Częstochowa Zakłady Przemysłu Zapalczanego SA, using a technology line from the 1930's. It is the only active match museum in Europe and the oldest match factory in Poland.*





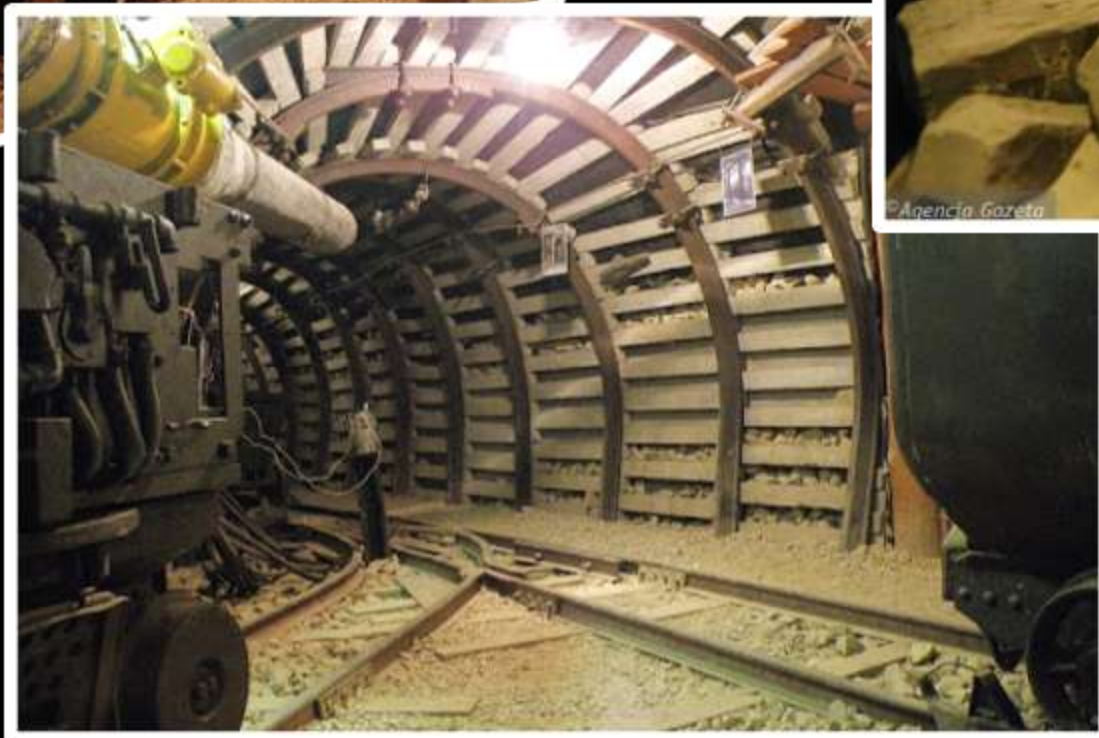




*The Iron Ore Mining Museum in Częstochowa - the museum in Częstochowa , located in the park Staszic running for the first time 4 December 1989 , built in the years 1974 - 1976 , the underground corridors. Former mine excavations were restored here, equipped with mining equipment from the closed Szczekaczka iron ore mine in Szczekaczka.*

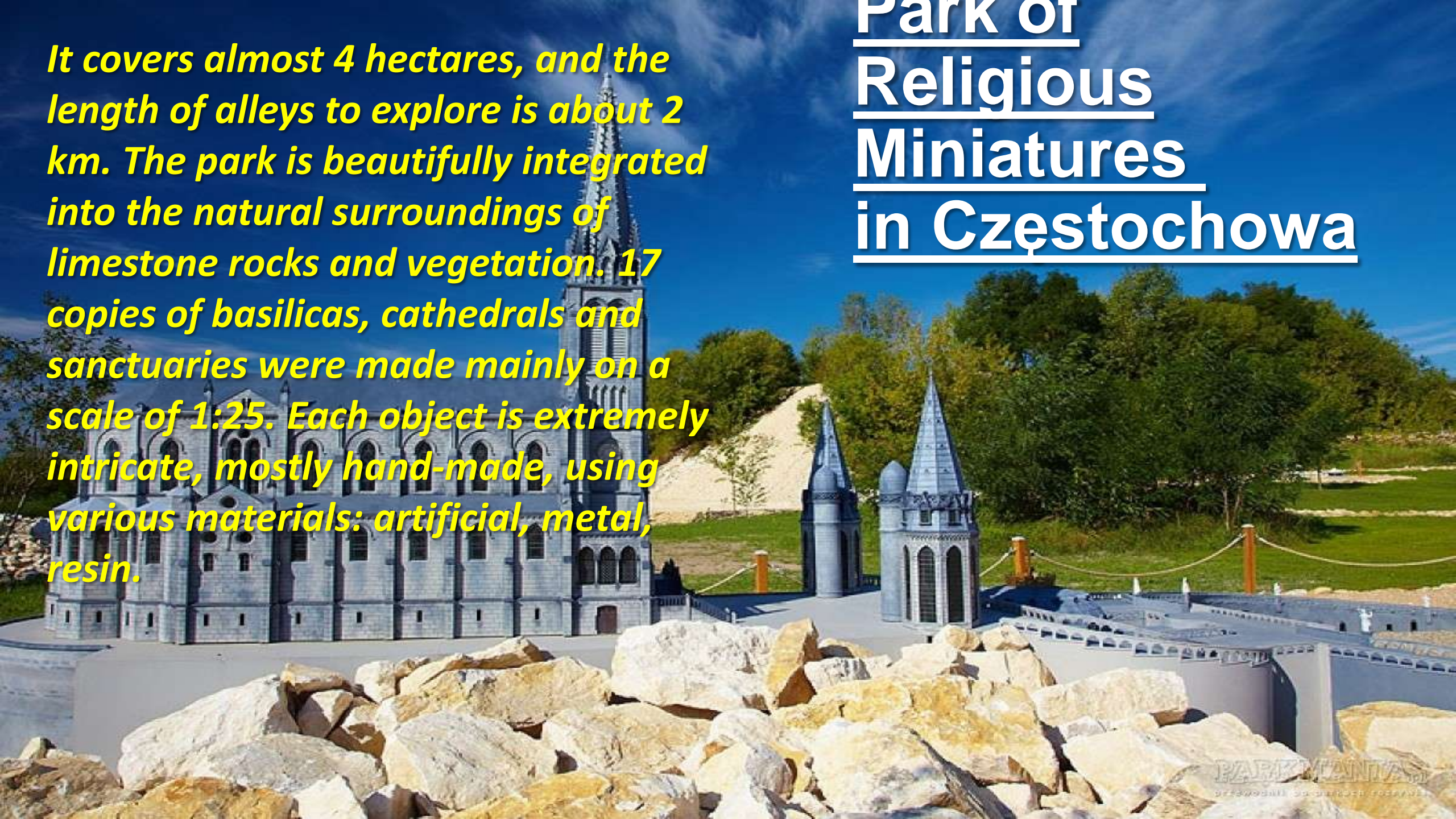






# Park of Religious Miniatures in Częstochowa

*It covers almost 4 hectares, and the length of alleys to explore is about 2 km. The park is beautifully integrated into the natural surroundings of limestone rocks and vegetation. 17 copies of basilicas, cathedrals and sanctuaries were made mainly on a scale of 1:25. Each object is extremely intricate, mostly hand-made, using various materials: artificial, metal, resin.*













# Ruins of the Castle in Olsztyn



*Olsztyn Castle - the ruins of the medieval castle located in the Kraków-Częstochowa Upland, built in the so-called Track of the Eagles' Nests, in the village of Olsztyn in Częstochowa powiat. Lots of legends are connected with this place.*












# Ruins of castle in Ogrodzieniec

The image shows the ruins of a late medieval castle in Ogrodzieniec, Poland. The castle is built on a rocky outcrop and features several towers and walls. The castle was built in the 14th-15th century by the Włodków Sulimczyk family.*







# Castle in Bobolice



*Castle in Bobolice - a noble's castle originally built in the mid-fourteenth century and then rebuilt. It is located in the Kraków-Częstochowa Upland, in the so-called Track of the Eagles' Nests, in the village of Bobolice. This is also a place full of legends.*

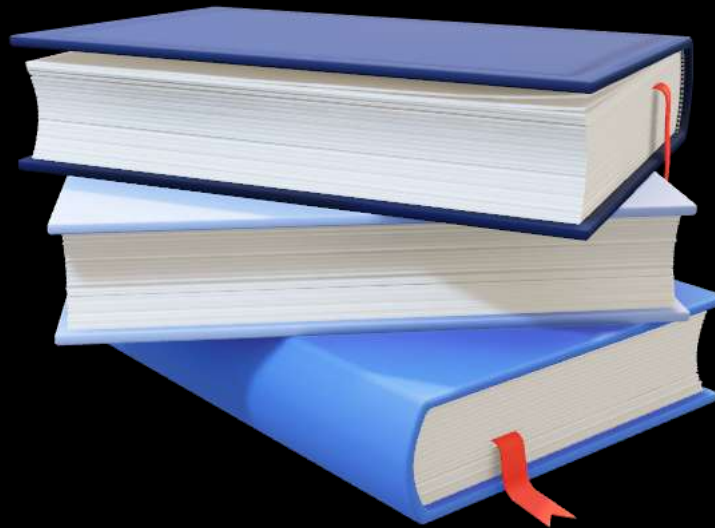
