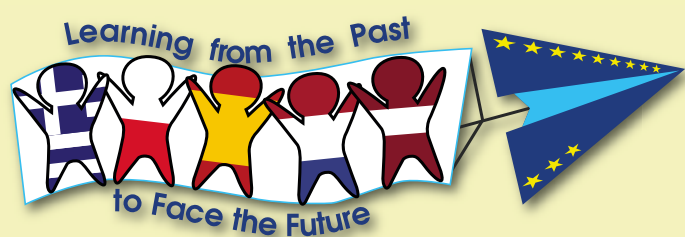

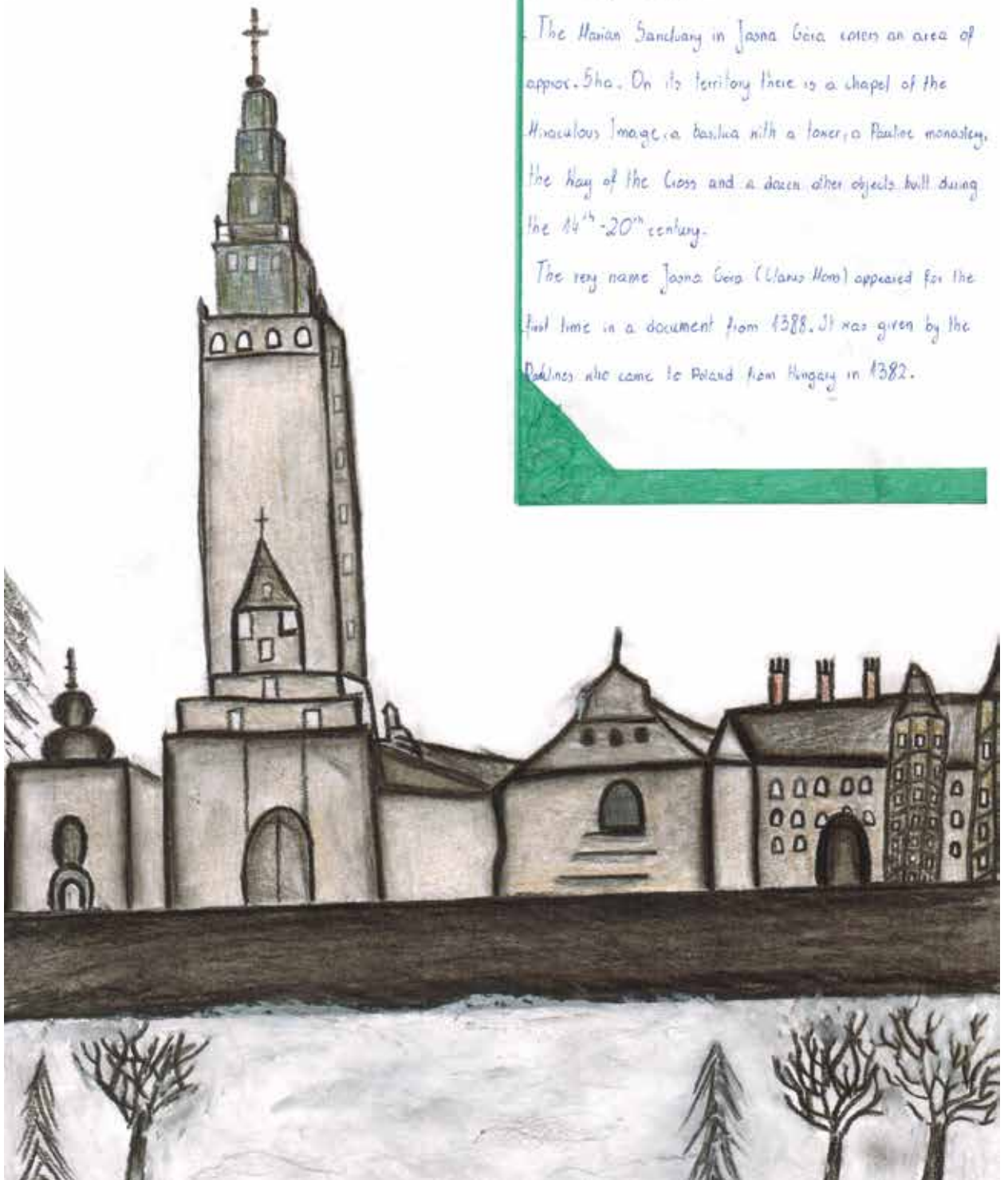
Jasna Góra

The Marian shrine in Jasna Góra in Częstochowa is the most famous shrine in Poland and the main destination of Polish pilgrims on foot. Annually, about 4 million people visit them, also from abroad.

Jasna Góra is also the world's largest center of Marian cult, which is associated with the cult of the image of the Mother of God, not revelations.

The Marian Sanctuary in Jasna Góra covers an area of approx. 5ha. On its territory there is a chapel of the Miraculous Image, a basilica with a tower, a Pauline monastery, the Way of the Cross and a dozen other objects built during the 14th-20th century.

The very name Jasna Góra ('White Mount') appeared for the first time in a document from 1388. It was given by the Radwiger, who came to Poland from Hungary in 1382.

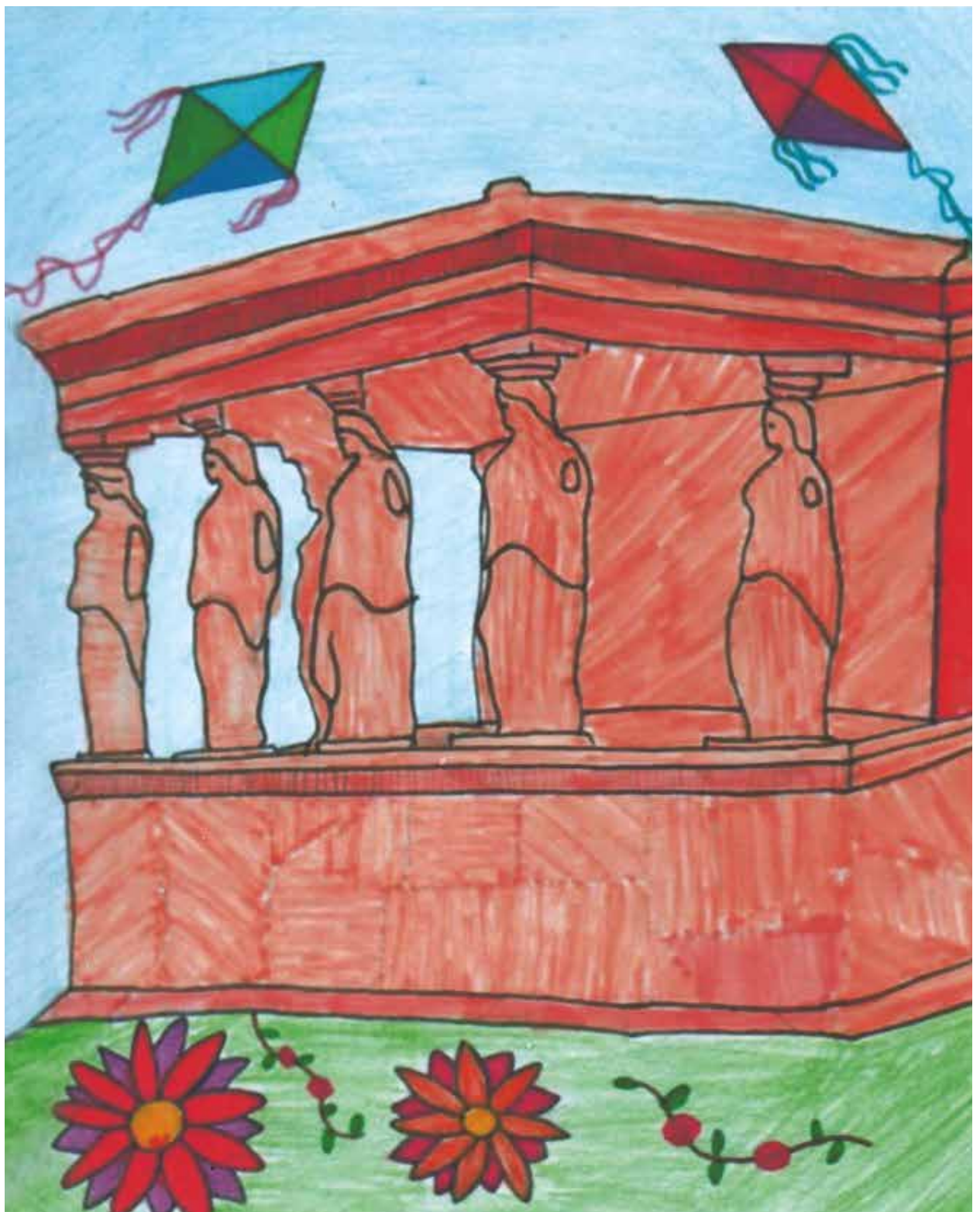

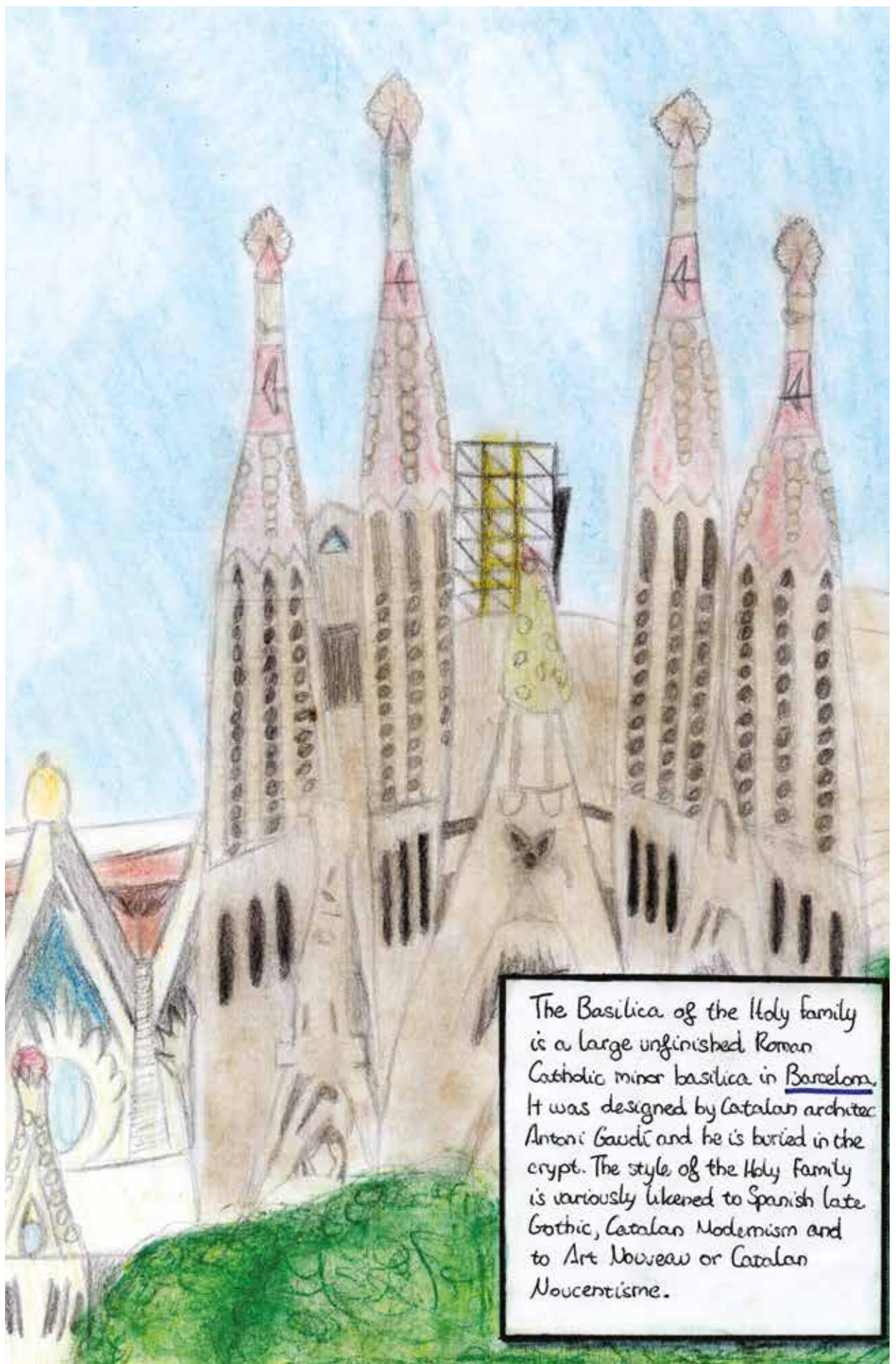
The Erechtheion is an ancient temple in the modern side of the Acropolis in Athens. The temple was dedicated to the goddess Athena and the god Poseidon. It was built between 421 and 406 BC. The Athenians used to keep the most ancient and most sacred relics there. Along one of its sides there are six women's figures instead of columns. They are dressed the same and have elaborate hairstyles, but although they look alike no one is exactly the same with another.

The fasting period for the Orthodox Church begins forty days before Easter, usually during March. The Monday of Lent was named so because the Christians are "cleansed" both spiritually and physically. It is a day of fasting, but also an official holiday for everyone. 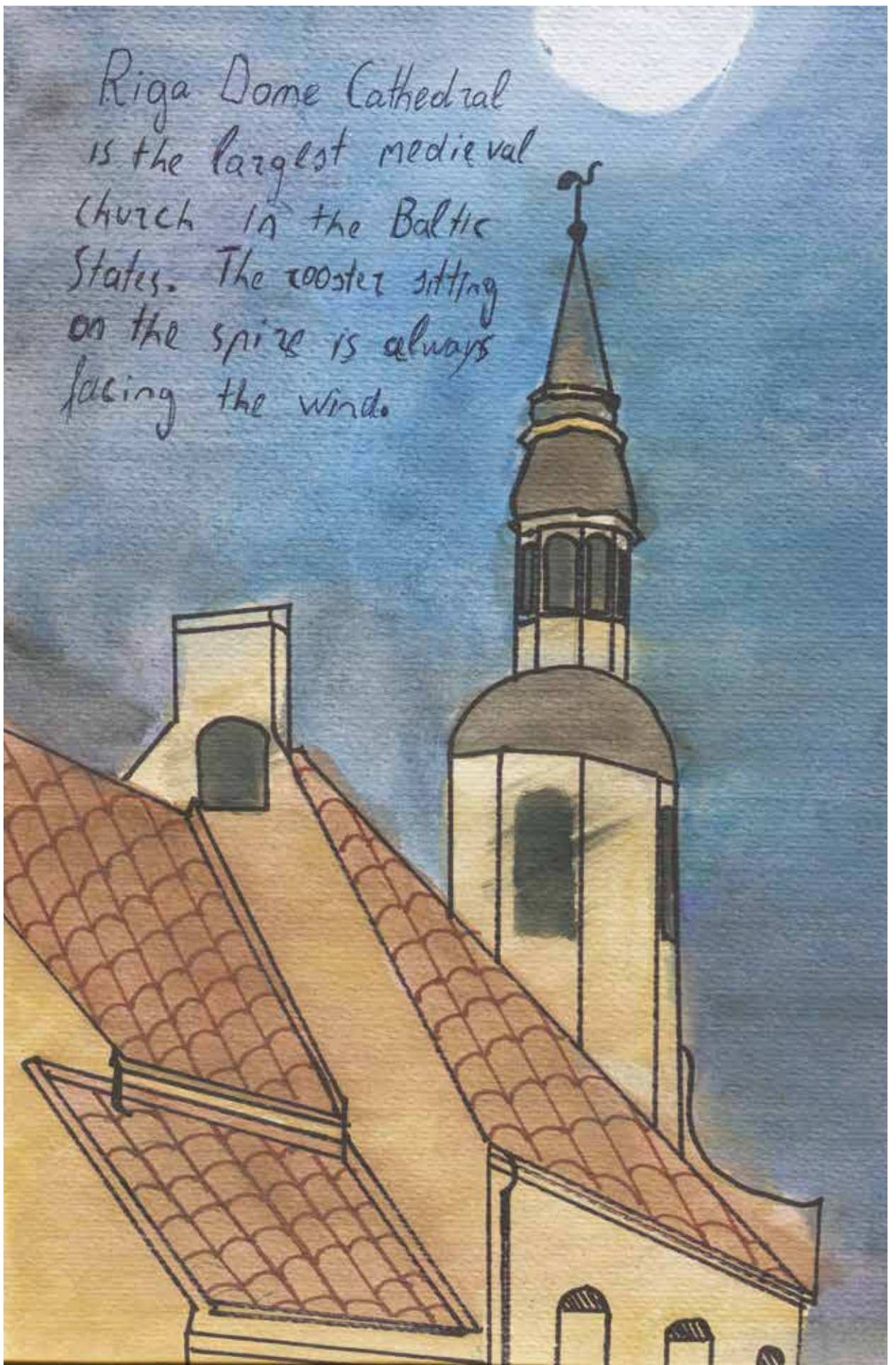

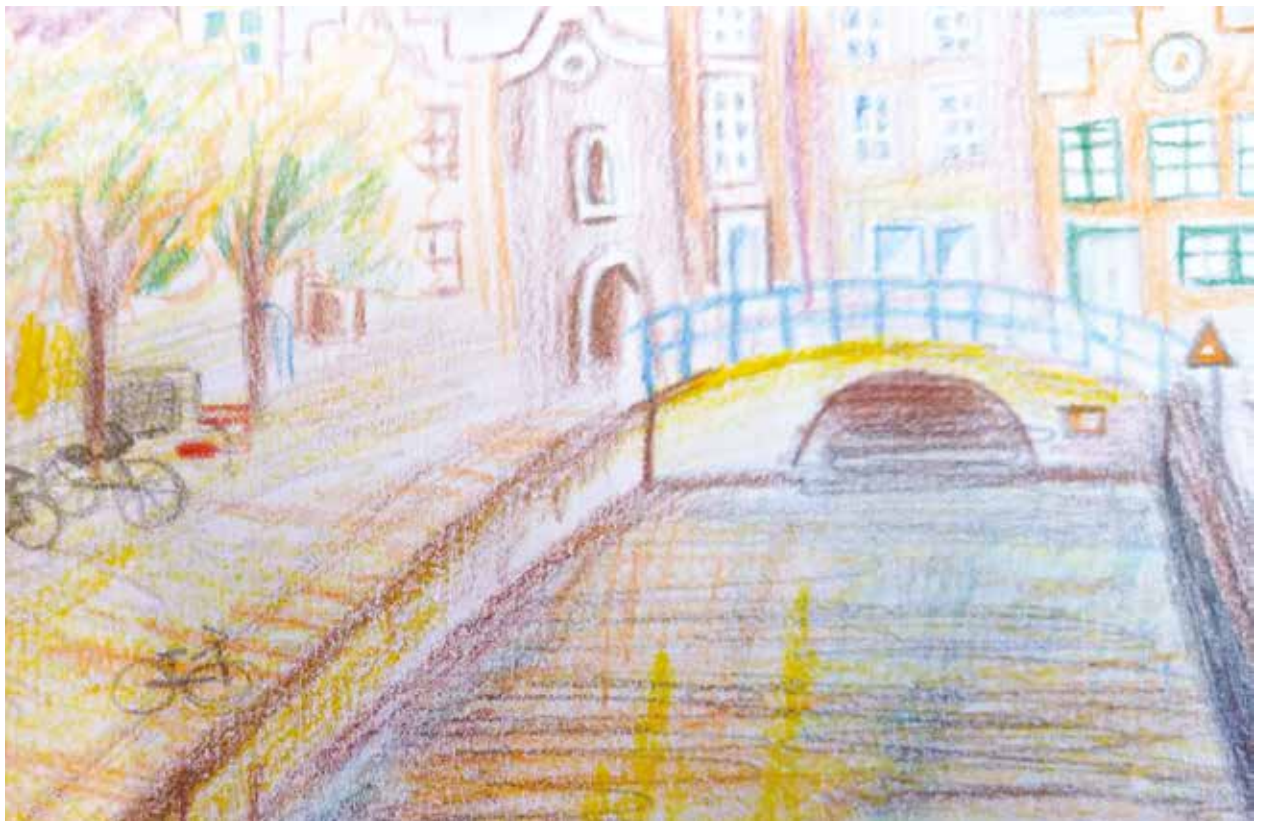


The archaeological site of Knossos is situated in Crete. Knossos was an important town of the ancient world with constant life from the end of the 7th millennium until the 5th century A.D. King Minos's base was there. The palace had an impressive size of 29,000 sq.m and was made of luxurious materials. It was a multistorey and complex building, decorated with multicoloured wall paintings. The royal apartments, the throne room, the banquet rooms, the laboratories, the sanctuaries and the storerooms were situated around a central yard. Wine was one of their main products. Since then, Greek people have been involved in viticulture. September is called "Vintager", because the grapes are harvested then. In a lot of places the pressing of grapes takes place the same way it used to in the antiquity.

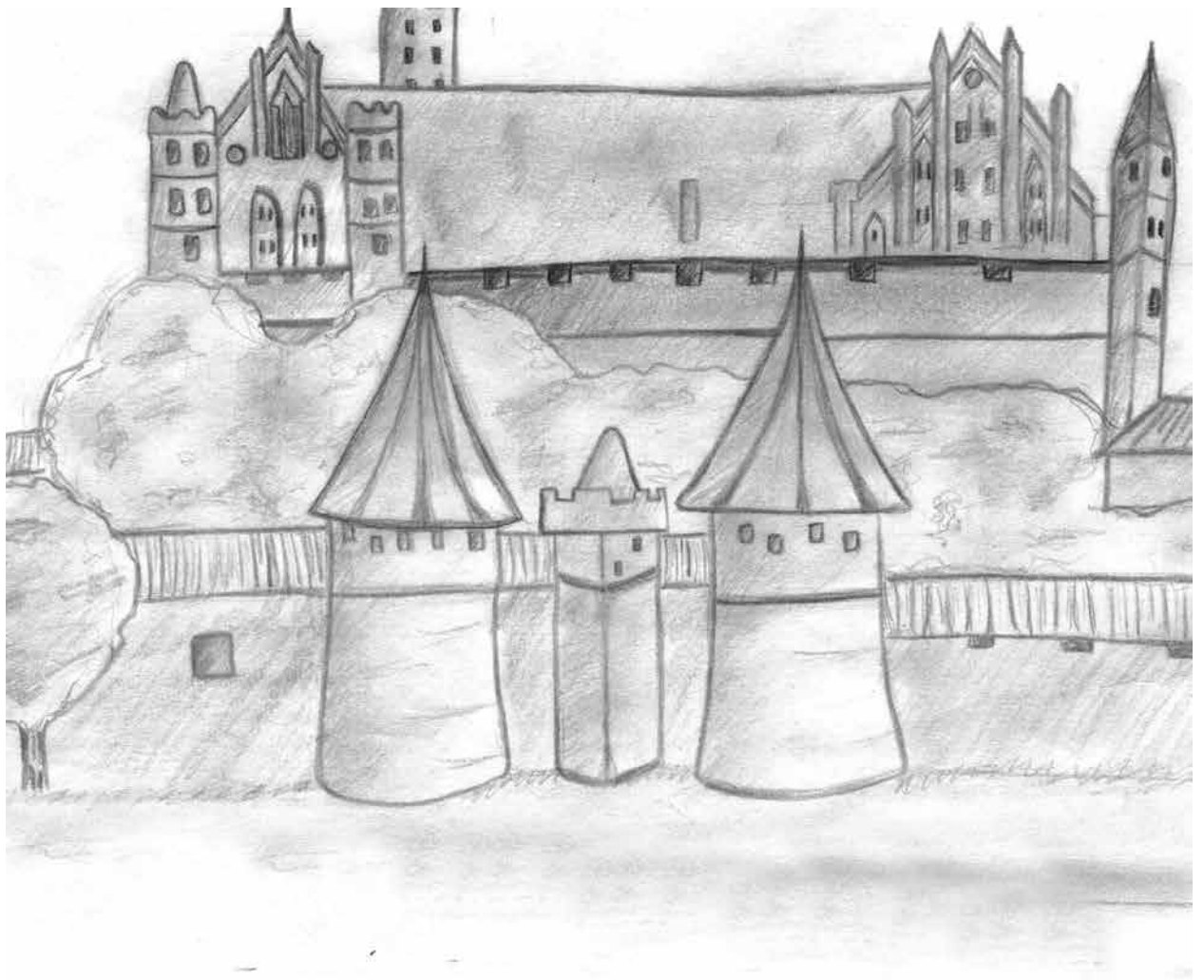

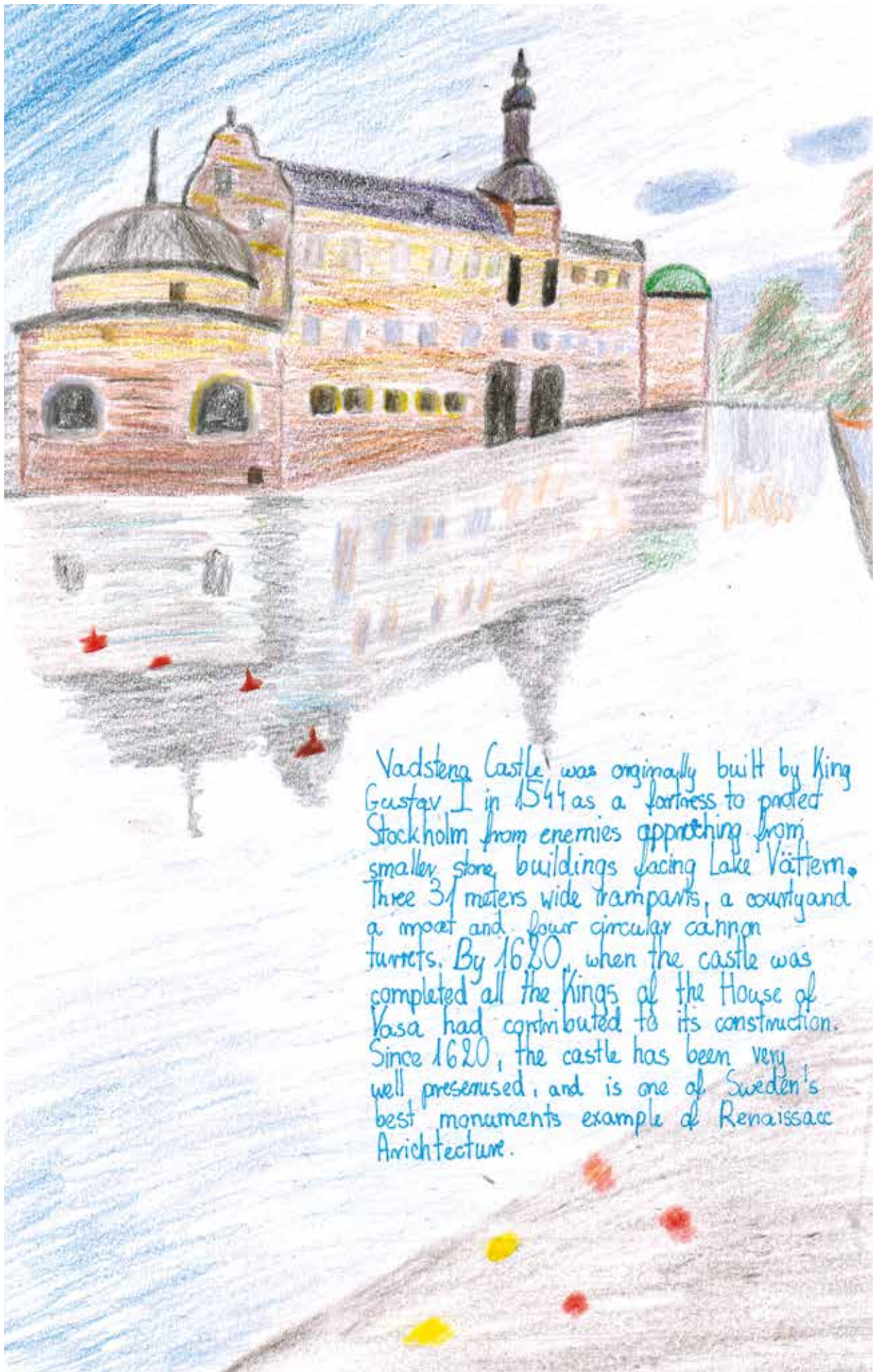


The Gothic castle in Malbork
