The kick off of the new Erasmus+ project was held from last September 25th to 29th in Preveza, Greece, at the school of the Greek partner “Gymnasium Preveza”. Six Nations took part in this meeting: Greece, Italy, Germany, Ireland, Cyprus and Spain.

Work started with a welcoming ceremony enlivened by traditional dances and chorus from the Greek culture and involving all the school students. It followed the presentation of the partner schools, of the different school systems and distinct approaches used regarding the integration of foreign students and motivational strategy to let the institution getting closer to students risking to abandon school early.

During the meeting we carried out a visit to the Preveza refugee camp where we saw volunteers from several associations working to alphabetize children running from war zones.

Work ended with a detailed scheduling of the tasks for the meeting to follow and with the planning of the other mobilities.
