In the afternoon we did a biking tour in order to get oriented in Seville and have a glimpse of all important places. We then had a traditional lunch near school.



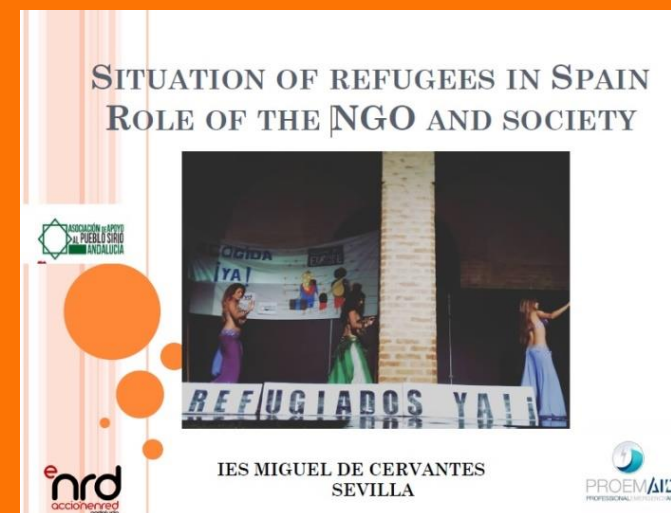
WEDNESDAY, 14th

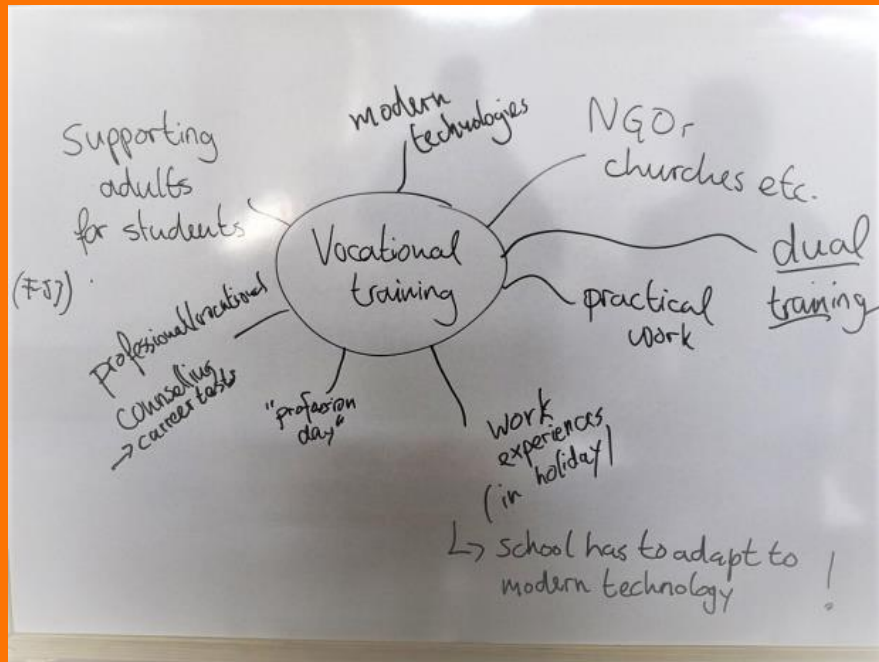
A Power Point presentation was also shown about the cooperation between IES Miguel De Cervantes and NGOs and other external agents in relation to the integration of immigrants.
