## THE LEGEND OF THE COAT OF ARMS

*In the days of yore, some 700 long years ago, the settlement of Lublin had grown so much that its residents began hoping and praying for a town charter. A delegation set out on the long trek to Kraków to see Duke Władysław I the Elbow-high and convince him that Lublin should be granted the charter. The inspired delegates spoke with great pride about their quickly-growing and beautiful settlement. They also related stirring stories, like of a group of children orphaned during the Tatar invasion who hid in the ravine and survived only thanks to being suckled by a goat. The Duke liked the story so much that he immediately granted Lublin the town charter, and suggested that this famous goat should be placed in the town's coat of arms. The delighted delegates quickly set about this task, but, as they were in want of funds, they found a local artisan who agreed to paint the coat of arms for a modest fee. Imagine their horror when they returned to Lublin and unpacked the precious bundle. What they saw, instead of a she-goat, was an old shaggy billy goat gorging on grapes. How could you show such a coat of arms to the residents? To their surprise, however, the residents were so euphoric about the newly granted town charter that they immediately forgave the artist and the delegates, forgot the mishap, and accepted the new coat of arms with delight and good will.*

Students read Winnie the Pooh's story as they wrote. They got their start in Winnie the Pooh story and then had to negotiate the sequel themselves.

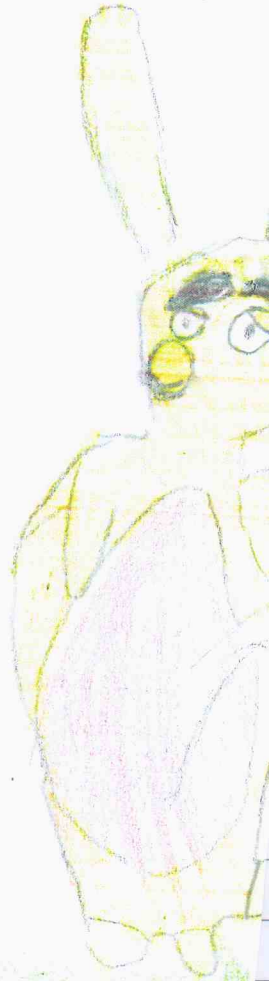

On the first day of 2020, he went with his two moms to pick up fireworks spikes.

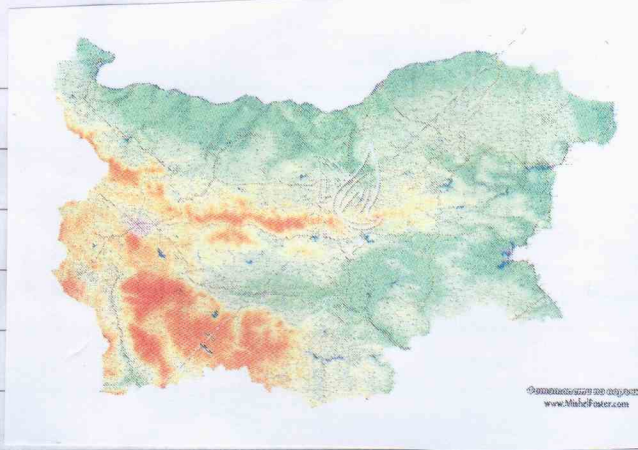

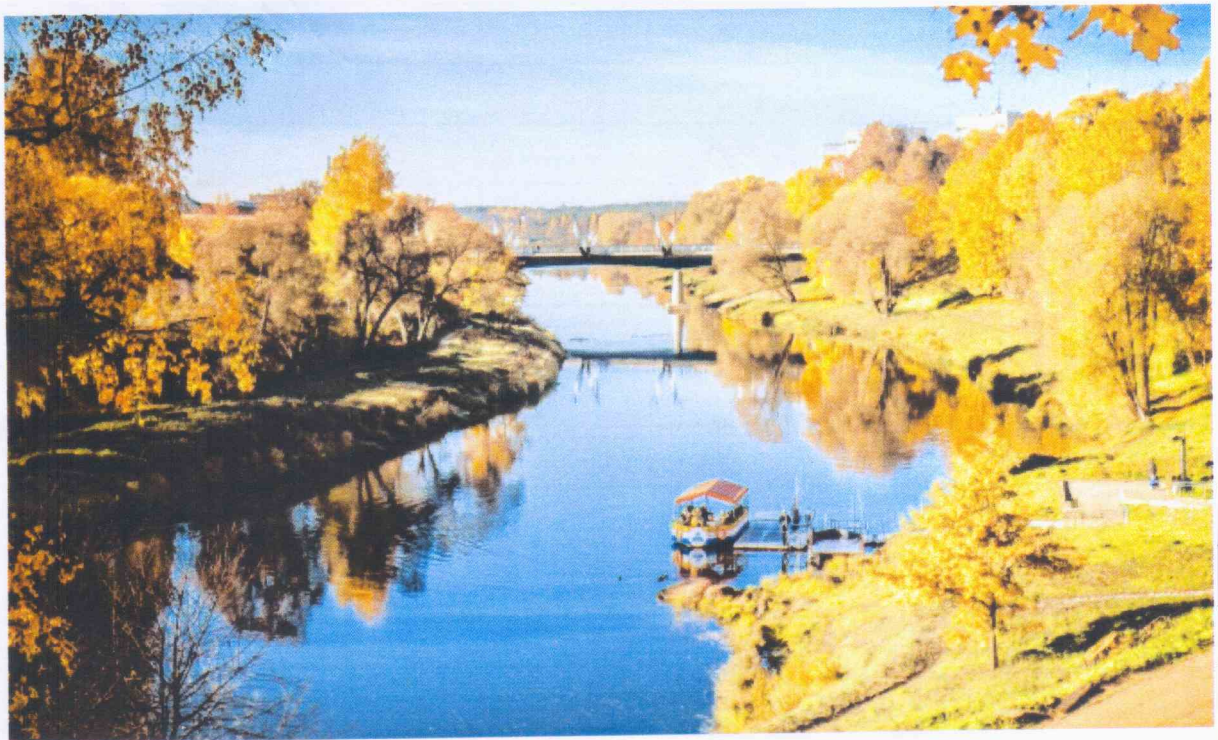
## Valmieras Pārgaujas Primary school
