Our kindergarten is a place where children find the world of childhood, where they are helped by the adults to find answers, to discover new things and to gain trust in themselves and in the good things.





There are 400 children in our kindergarten, organized into 16 groups: nine major groups, four medium groups and three small groups, all coordinated by 30 teachers.



We have traditional teaching groups, one step-by-step group and two Waldorf groups. Most of them have extended program for preschoolers.







At the kindergarten, all children play, learn, tell stories and can be small actors. They are friends, they have contests and they celebrate. The kindergarten is a big family!









Many of our activities with children are organised outdoor. We play in our own yard or in the park, we visit our educational partners and we discover the world.











In the kindergarten the preschoolers participate in optional games and activities such as chess, Go, dancing, painting, singing or karate.



Teachers and preschoolers are involved in extracurricular projects to promote a healthy and friendly life.





Between 2014-2016 we were partners in the Erasmus+ program, being part of the "Experiments-the best learning science" project.





Between 2016 and 2018 we were partners in the project "Fearless child makes a cheerful child"





Our story is "The baby goat that had three (mother-) goats" by Octav Pancu Iasi. We chose this story together with the children and their parents. Children are inspired by the text to draw sequences from the story.





The children used the text of the story to create small dramatizations. They are actors and they play the roles of the characters in this story.
