- 1. Go to mahara.gimb.org.
- 2. Use your username and password and make sure you change it as soon as possible.
- 3. Create your profile and do not forget to add your photo.

How to create a page?

You add a new page in your portfolio when you want to display artefacts¹ together, e.g. for presenting them to others, for showing your progress in a project etc.

How to share?

- 11. Once you create a page you need to share it with your teacher.
- 12. Above you have different buttons such as SETTINGS, EDIT and SHARE.
- 13. Choose SHARE. Go to SHARE WITH and find a USER. Do not forget to SAVE IT.
- 14. Do not put a timeframe to it, because your teacher can have some difficulties while seeing it.

¹ Artefacts are all types of content that you add to your personal content area, i.e. text, journal entries, pictures, audio files, video files, images etc.

² You can ask other users and / or friends to comment on your pages and / or collections that you have shared. Comments should be constructive and helpful.
