Being part of an intercultural school project like ours means stepping out of one's comfort zone. Throughout the mobilities the guest students experience what it means to be thrown into a different culture ("the unknown"). The hosts learn what it takes to accommodate someone from a different background, to help them adjust and feel comfortable. Hence, this week's topic "Intercultural communication" couldn't be more suitable.

As students from four different European countries, you will have discovered certain differences already and most certainly also a lot of similarities. However, one thing that we all have in common as Europeans is the refugee crisis. Besides the intake of refugees, their integration is a highly debated issue.

In order to put the theoretical knowledge that you've gained in the Intercultural communication workshop into a bigger perspective, you will have the chance to interview a refugee from Syria about the integration process in his "host culture" Germany.



**Amin (Tuesday) and Soliman (Wednesday) have found the strength to speak up, now it's your turn.**

Each student has to prepare at least two questions for the interview on Tuesday/Wednesday.

Imagine you are forced to flee your home country in order to be safe. *If you had five minutes to pack, what would you take?* Or imagine you are helping refugees in your community. *How does it change your identity?*

Within your international group, take on both perspectives and develop a plan of both *how to help refugees integrate into the new culture* and *how helping them can expand your horizon*.

Prepare a presentation that will include:

- An individual experience of a refugee – What would you take with you? Where would you go? How would you like to be treated?
- An individual experience of accepting a refugee in your house – How would you help him/her integrate? Where would you take him/her? What kind of help would you offer?

The presentation:

- should not be longer than 5 minutes
- should be made with a tool that was presented to you during the ICT workshop (prezi, powtoon, genial.ly etc.)
- should address all the problems stated above
- should include the names of the group members
- should allow everyone to contribute with his/hers ideas

On Friday you will present your work to others.
