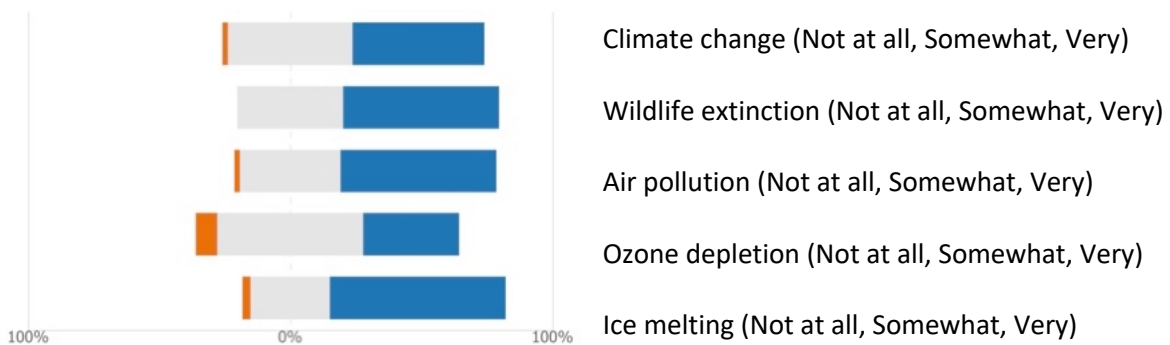
- 61 girls and 36 boys, 3 didn't want to say

- 15 students has been earlier in school project



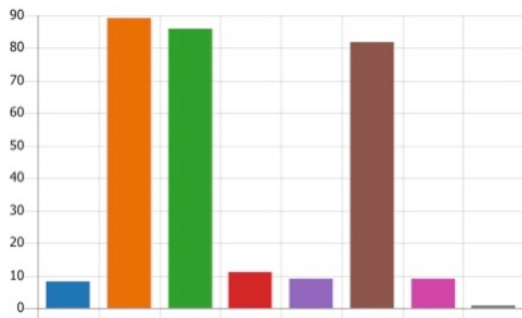
Almost everyone knew what climate change is (94%). They also thought that humans take action to stop climate change (96%)

 - Both 12%

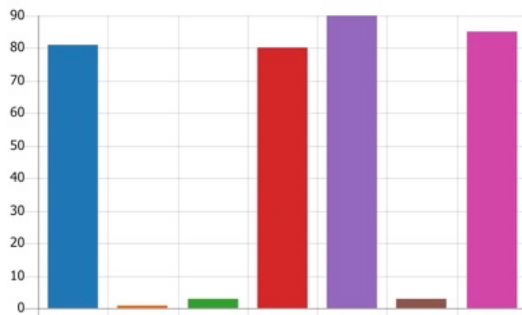

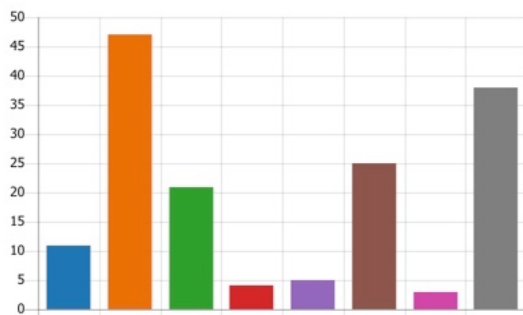

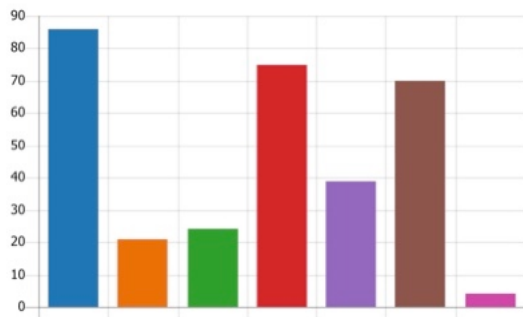

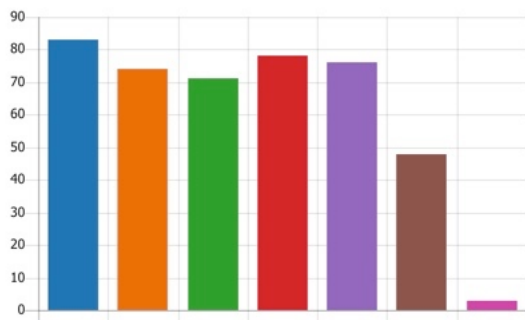
